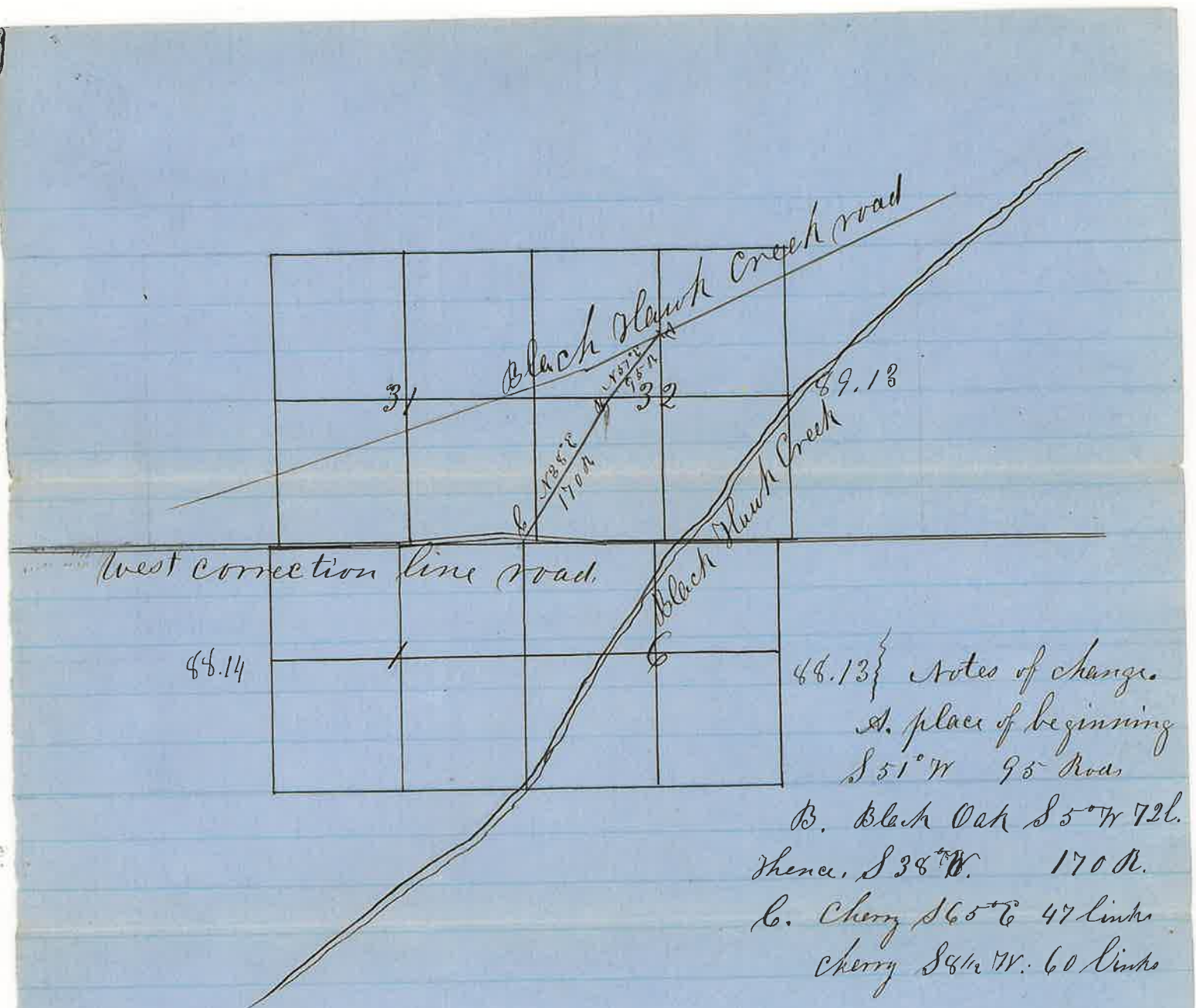

of sec. 32. be discontinued.

in the sum of Fifty Dollars for the payment of which, well and
truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, and every of them, firmly by these presents.

THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That, whereas,

has this day made application by petition, to the
County Court of said County, to appoint a ^{if necessary to survey & change in the Black Hawk Creek Road} commissioner to view and locate a road, called
Petitioned for by John Elwood and others

NOW, If the said road shall be established according to law, and the same becomes a public highway, in accordance with the statute
in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be void: otherwise, to be and remain in full force and virtue.
