of section Eighteen thence North along said section line One mile and a
quarter or thereabouts to a high ridge of land thence in a North Westerly course
to the East line of South East of the South West of Iowa thence in a Western
course on or near the traveled Road to the West side of the Cedar Valley
Railroad Road Survey thence along the West side of said survey to a
deep Ravine thence West to the State Road. thence along said
State Road to the Correction line between Townships Eighty-Eight and
Township Eighty-Nine Range Thirteen We therefore ask that a
Commissioner be appointed to view and said Road and report
upon the same as your petitioners will ever pray

and J. B. Dorey of the County of
Black Hawk and State of Iowa, are held and firmly bound unto the County of Black Hawk
in the sum of One hundred Dollars for the payment of which, well and
truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, and every of them, firmly by these presents.

THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That, whereas, Jacob Koch
et al. have ~~at~~ this day made application by petition, to the
County Court of said County, to appoint a commissioner to view and locate a road, called The Koch
road.

NOW, If the said road shall be established according to law, and the same becomes a public highway, in accordance with the statute
in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be void: otherwise, to be and remain in full force and virtue.

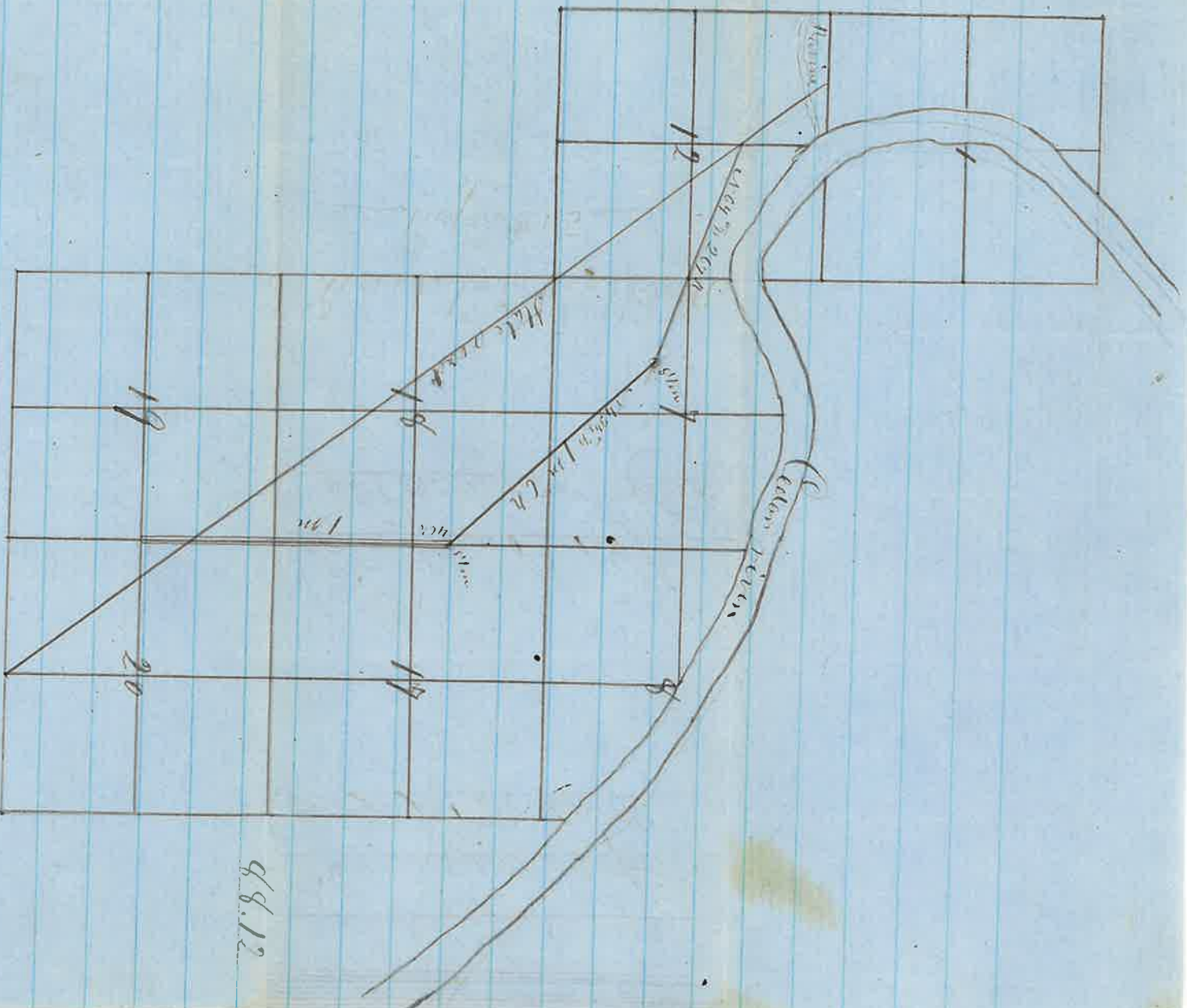

Section line One mile and a half for thumbouts to a high ridge of land, thence
in a Northwesterly direction to the East line of the S.E. of the S.W. of Section
