Upon the application of Asa B. Rowe, a part of a Road petitioned for by Albert Sergeant and Others, commencing at the S. E. corner of Section eleven, in Township eighty eight, Range fourteen, running thence South to the South line of said County;

Upon the application of S. D. McDowall, the Road leading from Waterloo to Cedar Falls on the West side of Cedar River;

Upon the application of John Clark, the Road leading from Waterloo to Spring Creek, upon the east side of Cedar River;

And upon the application of Sullivan Day, the Road leading from Waterloo to Pilot Grove, have been resurveyed and platted by order of the County Court of said County, and the several plats and field-notes thereof, returned and filed in the office of the County Judge; and that at the July Term, A. D. 1859 of said Court, unless good cause be shown to the contrary, the said County Court will approve said resurveys and plats severally, and order that each of the same be recorded, as in cases of the original establishment of Public Highways, according to Chapter 120 of the Session Laws of 1857.

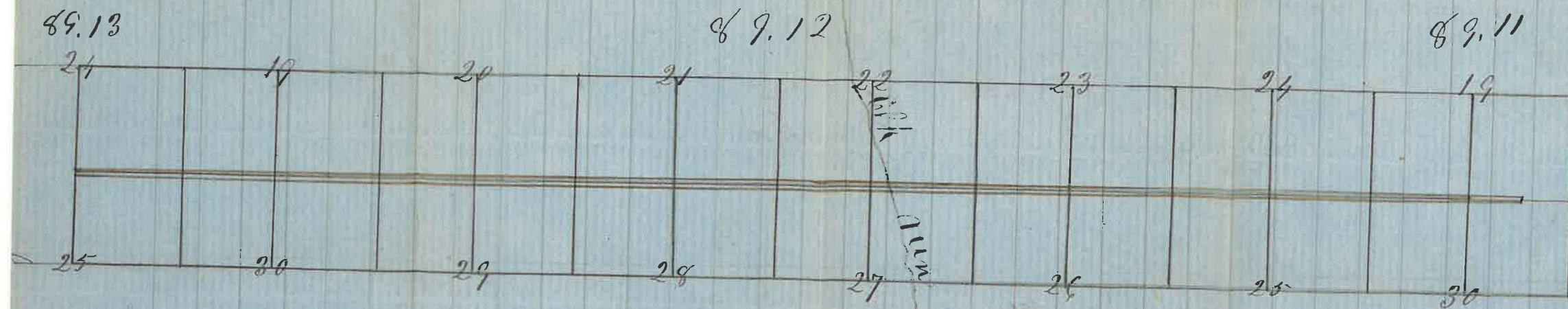

lor to Pilot Grove, in obedience to which I did exam-

did run & stake out said road in manner follow-
ing. Beginning at the North West corner of Section
Twenty five T 89. N R 13 W. Thence East along section lines
seven & one half miles & intersected the road leading from
Cedar Falls to Pilot Grove March 14th 1854
