of the County of

Black Hawk and State of Iowa, are held and firmly bound unto the County of Black Hawk
in the sum of Fifty Dollars for the payment of which, well and

truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, and every of them, firmly by these presents.

THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That, whereas,

James Baker et al. have this day made application by petition, to the
County Court of said County, to appoint a commissioner to view and locate a road, called the James
Baker Road

NOW, If the said road shall be established according to law, and the same becomes a public highway, in accordance with the statute
in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be void: otherwise, to be and remain in full force and virtue.

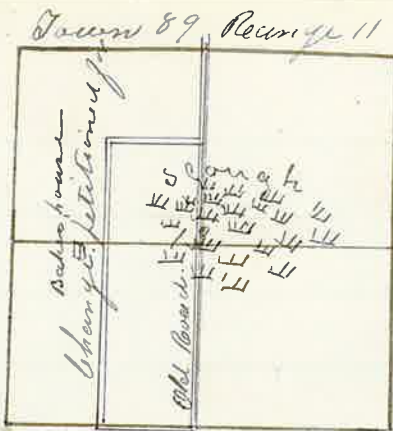

To the Honorable County Court of Black Hawk Co. Stat of Iowa
 According to a commission from the County Court
 of Black Hawk County State of Iowa and to me
 duly issued and directed by Clerk of said Court
 authorizing me to view, on the 26th day of
 December A.D. 1857, ^{and locate if required} a change in State Road petitioned
 for by Joseph Becker et al. commencing at the S.E.
 corner of the W. 1/4 of Sec 13 T 89 R 11, Thence
 W 80 Rods Thence N 240 Rods Thence E 80 Rods to
 intersect said State Road.

Having viewed said Road as required by com-
 mission I find the Road practicable and very much
 superior to the old one and believing that the
 petitioners will be much benefited by said change
 would recommend that said change be established
 I have therefore surveyed said Road the Plot
 of which I here return together with field Notes
 whereby we may be better acquainted with the
 Thence west 80 Rods Thence North 240 Rods 18 Links
 Thence East 80 Rods to its intersection with State
 Road.
