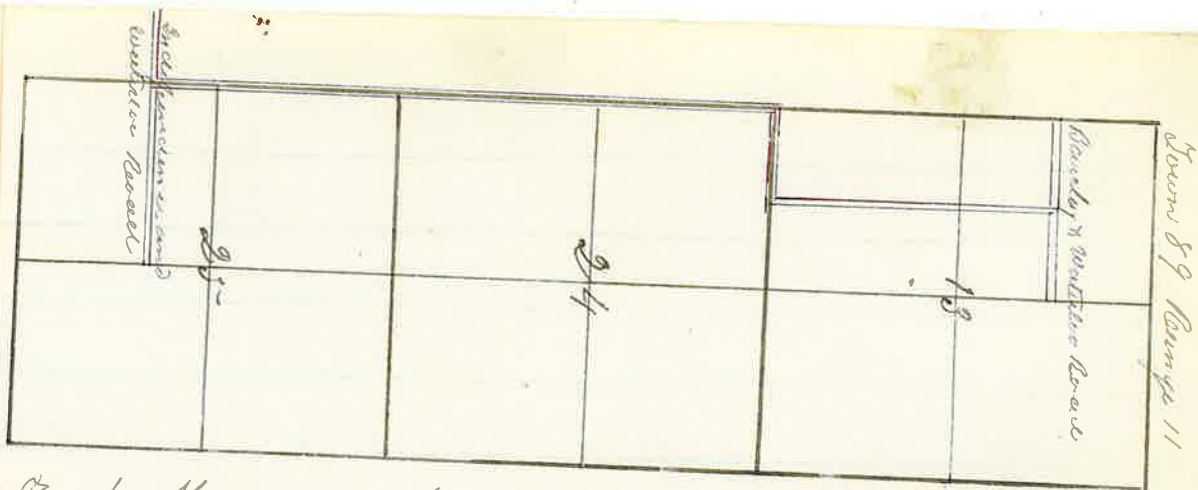

To the Honorable County Court of Blount County
State of Iowa

According to a Commission from the County Court of Black Hawk County State of Iowa and to me duly issued and directed by select of said court authorizing me to view on the 27th day of December Ad 1859. and locate if required a county Road petitioned for by Henry Fry Et Al. Commencing where the Independence and Waterloo Road crosses the sec line between sec 25 & 26 T89. R11, thence North on sec line to South west cor of sec 12 thence East 80 Rods thence North to intersect Barclay and Waterloo Road. Having viewed said Road as required by Commission I find it practicable and believing that the petitioners will be much benefited by said road I would recommend that said road be established.

I have therefore surveyed and plotted said Road which ^{I am returning} Plot together with field notes as follows. To wit Commencing where the Independence and Westview Road crosses Sec line between Sec. 23 & 26 Town 89 Range 11 57 Rods south of $\frac{1}{4}$ part on west line of Sec 25. Thence North on Sec line one mile and 217 Rods to the S.W. corner of Sec 13, T 89, R 11. Thence west 80 Rods. Thence North 540 Rods, 18 Links to intersect Barclay and Westview Road.

Know all Men by these Presents, THAT WE, Joseph Baker of the County of Blackhawk and State of Iowa, are held and firmly bound unto the County of Blackhawk in the sum of Fifty Dollars for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, and every of them, firmly by these presents.

THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That, whereas, Henry and others have this day made application by petition, to the County Court of said County, to appoint a commissioner to view and locate a road, called the Henry Road NOW, if the said road shall be established according to law, and the same becomes a public highway, in accordance with the statute in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be void: otherwise, to be and remain in full force and virtue.
