the 28th day of Dec. 1859 and locate if required
a County Road petitioned for by J. F. Rice et al.
Commencing at the S.W. corner of Sec 1, T. 89
R. 11, thence North on Sec line one half mile
thence East one half mile to center of said
Sec. Having viewed said Road as required
by Commission I find it practicable and
I believe the petitioners will be much benefited
by said Road and I would recommend that
the said Road be established. I have therefore
surveyed and plotted said Road which I plot
I have returned together with with field notes as follows
to wit: Commencing at the South west corner of
Sec 1 Town 89 Range 11. Thence North on Sec line
between Sec 1 & 2. one half mile to $\frac{1}{4}$ post.
