According to previous appointments as
Commissioner to locate a County Road from
the Connection Line west of Cedar River between
Townships 89 and 89 and 13 and 14, and run-
ning from thence North on said line to inter-
sect the present Road leading from Waterloo
to Cedar Falls; - I appeared at the office of
the County Clerk in said County on the 13th day
of February A.D. 1860. and qualified according
to Law, and proceeded immediately to the dis-
charge of my duty as Commissioner. -

After a thorough examination, which had to
be done by having said line with a compass,
with the assistance of one person employed at
my expense. - I have deemed the location
of said Road inexpedient at the present time,
by taking into consideration the expense of said ^{work,}
the fear that would at present be benefited by
said Road, and the fact that a County Road
is now established parallel with this proposed road
but one half mile west, and running through
the center of the first tier of Section west of said
line and entering Cedar Falls precisely on Main
Street - Therefore I reserve (and object)
the location of said Road, at the present time
to be inexpedient; for the consideration above
stated. -
