Known as the Cedar Falls and Forest City Road Commencing at a stake in the center of the State Road five chains and seventy five links south of the North East Corner of the south west $\frac{1}{4}$ of the South west $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 28 Township 90 Range 14 Thence North forty five degrees East itine chains and twenty five links Thence North three degrees West Eleven chains and seventy five links to intersect the State Road and that a Commissioner may be appointed to view said change & make Other action may be had as will establish a change as Prayed for in said Petition.

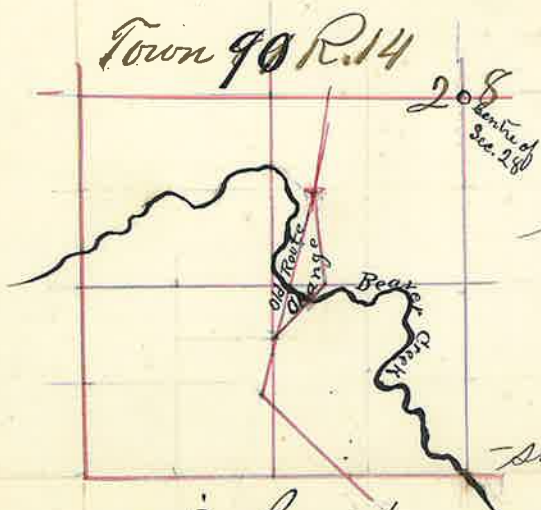

Black Hawk and State of Iowa, are held and firmly bound unto the County of Black Hawk
in the sum of one hundred Dollars for the payment of which, well and
truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, and every of them, firmly by these presents.

THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That, whereas, D. G. James
Allen Webster & others has this day made application by petition, to the
County Court of said County, to appoint a commissioner to view and locate a road, called Called a part of
The Cedar Valley & Forest City Road

NOW, If the said road shall be established according to law, and the same becomes a public highway, in accordance with the statute
in such cases made, and provided, then this obligation to be void: otherwise, to be and remain in full force and virtue.
