North Easterly in said 4th St. to Chestnut St. thence
North Westerly in Chestnut St. to a point which when
extended North will run through Main St in
road road addition, thence north to Angyle
St. thence East in Angyle St. to the Waterloo & Beresly

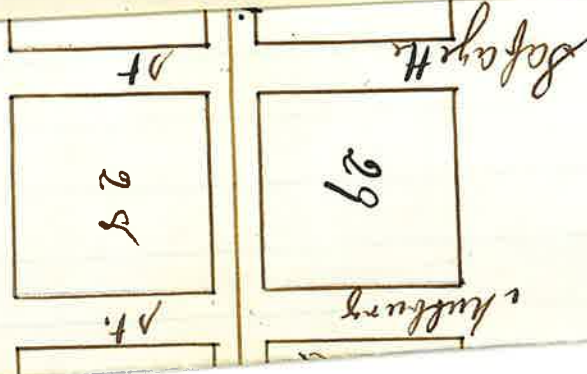

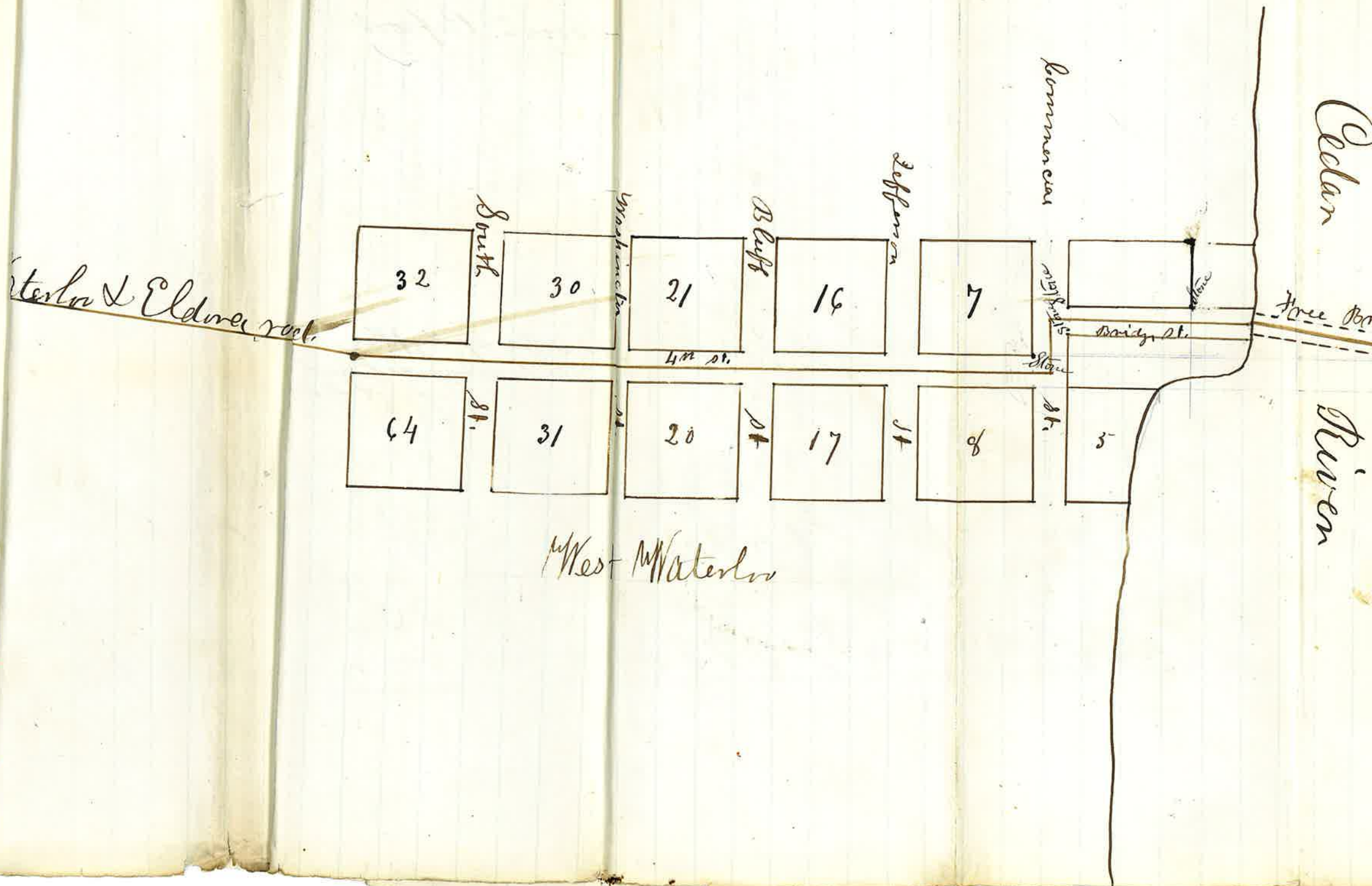

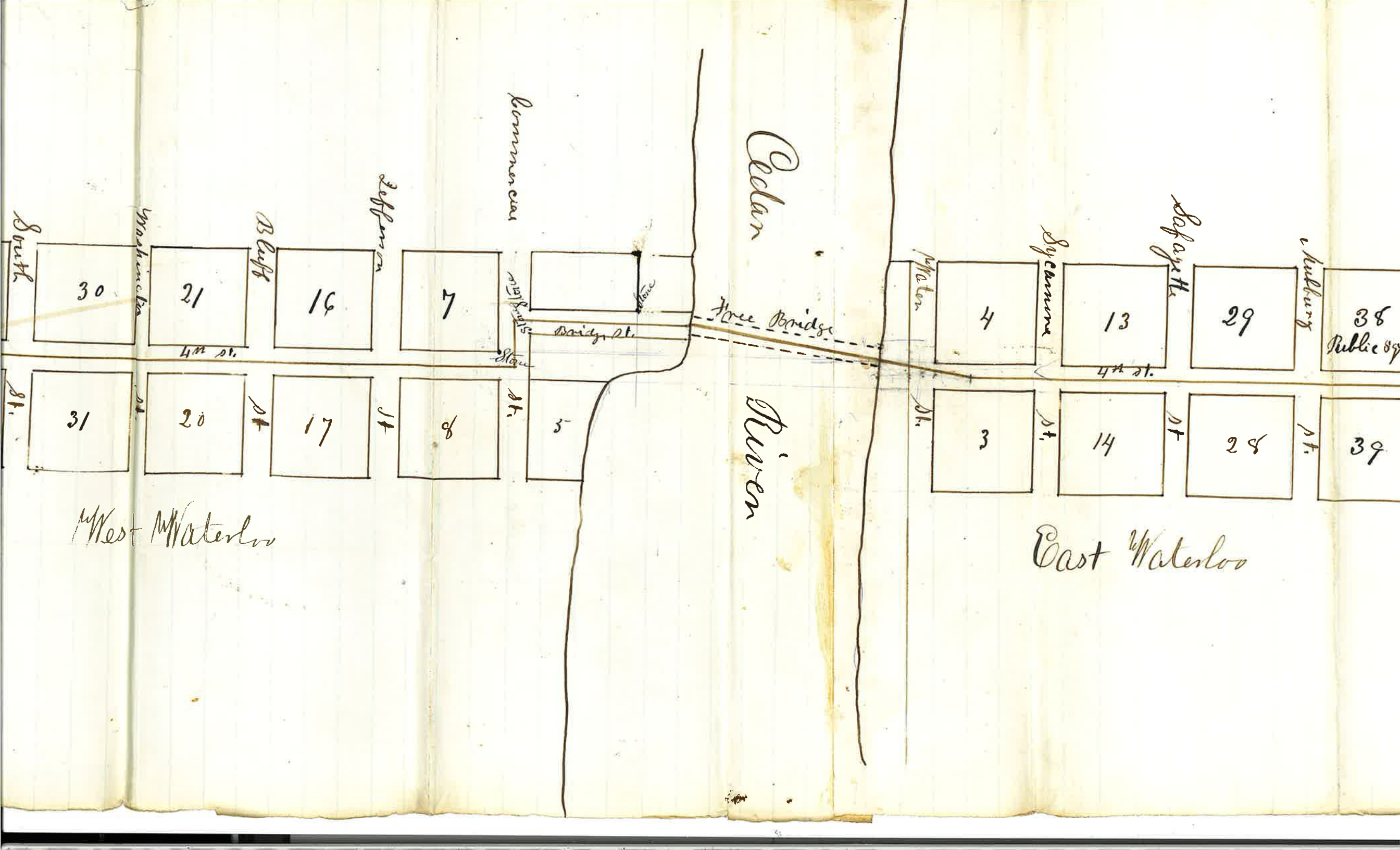
