County Road No. 76 running along the North Side of the West Half ($W\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southeast Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 24-87-11; the North Side of the Southwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 24 Township 87 Range 11; and the West Side of the North Half ($N\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 24 Township 87 Range 11.
2. County Road No. 191 running East and West between Sections 24 and 25 in Township 89 Range 11.
3. County Road No. 548 running North and South between Sections 35 and 36 in Township 89 Range 11.
4. The East three-fourth ($E\frac{3}{4}$) of a mile of County Road No. 438 running East and West between Sections 4 and 9 in Township 89 Range 12.
5. That part of County Road No. 143 running through Sections 13 and 14 Township 90 Range 11.

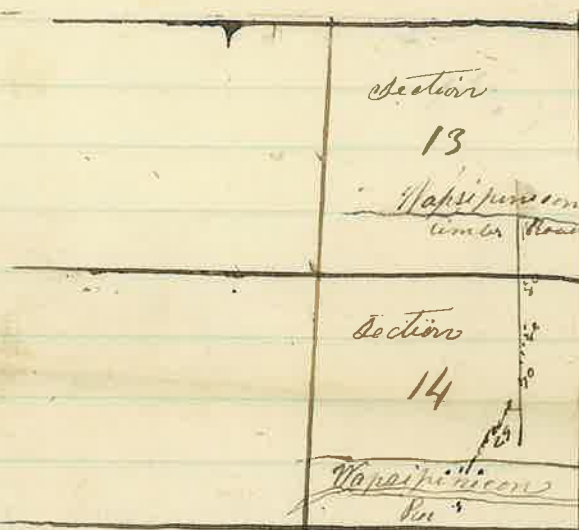
