

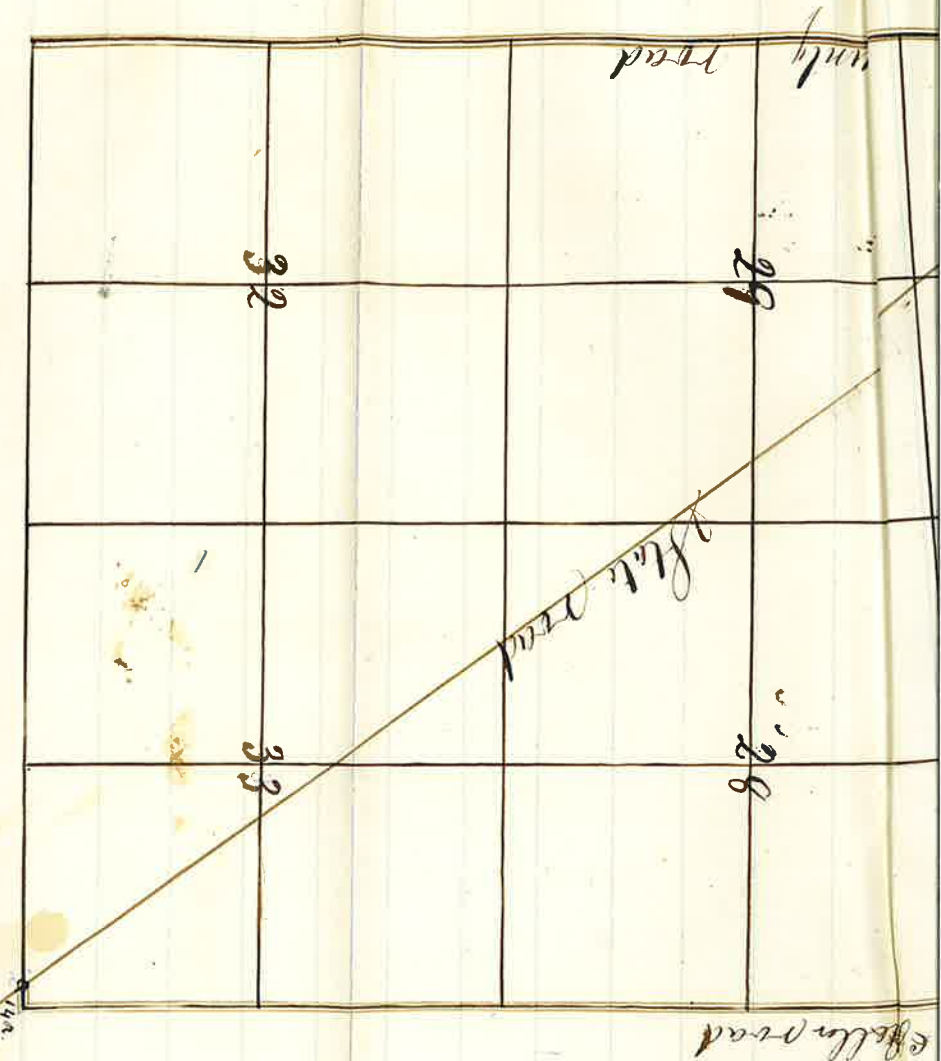

August 1862



The purchase of a commission issued out of the
County Court of Black Hawk County Iowa on the 3rd
day of June 1862 to me the Special Agent the
purpose of establishing a county road as follows
to wit, Commencing 14 rods west of N. B. E.,
corner of Section No. 33 in Township No. 88 Range
No. 12 west in the middle of the said road, thence
running east 14 rods to N. B. E., corner of said
section, thence north and northwesterly until
it intersects the County road, as shown by the
above plot. I examined said road and
found it tolerably fair, about as well as could
well be obtained in that section of the County.
And in consequence of a neighborhood meeting
held in that vicinity I would
recommend its establishment as a public
high way, length of road 5 miles 10 rods.
Mounds were thrown up and put out
at all the angles

notice is hereby given that there will be a petition presented to the Board of Supervisors at the January term A.D. 1862 asking the appointment of the Commissioners to examine into the propriety of locating a County road as follows to wit: commencing in the Cedar Falls and Cedar Rapids state road between section nos 33 & 34 T 88 R 12 west in Black Hawk Co Iowa then running north to Cedar river thence north westerly to north $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of sec. no. 21 in said Township & Range, thence west to section no. 17 on the best ground between 2 lakes, thence north westerly to north line of south half of north west $\frac{1}{4}$ sec 17. Thence west until it intersects the state road and report upon the same. Said road to be called the McHeller road.
