County in the Sum of fifty Dollars
dollars for the payment of which
wee bind ourselves and Executors and
administrators jointly and severly
Whereas Joseph Huskell and William Thib have
applied to the Board of Supervisors of
Blackhawk County Iowa for the establi-
shment of a county Road described as follow-
Commencing at the Section line between
Section 5 five and Section 6 six where
said Section line crosses the Waterloo
and Eldora Road in Lincoln Township
and following said Section line South to the
County line of Tama. Now if the said petitioners
shall pay all the expenses growing out of the
application for said road if it shall not be
established by said Board the above obligation
shall be void otherwise to remain in full
force and effect in testimony we have hereunto
set our hands
