for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, and every of them, firmly, by these presents.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such, That, whereas

Levi Washburn has this day made application, by petition, to the *County Court* of *Blackhawk* county, to make a change in the *road* of said county, to appoint a commissioner to view and locate a county road, called *road* *across the section line road from* *Wetzel to Independence*

Now, if the said *road* shall be established according to law, and the same become a public highway, in accordance with the statute in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be *carriage* of said *petitioner* void: otherwise, to be and remain in full force and virtue.
