& other has this day made application by petition, to the
County Court of said County, to appoint a commissioner to view and locate a road, called Haysen
Road

NOW, If the said road shall be established according to law, and the same becomes a public highway, in accordance with the statute
in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be void: otherwise, to be and remain in full force and virtue.

To the Honorable Board of Supervisors of Black Hawk County:

Your

petitioner respectfully shows that a public highway was established in the year One Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-four (1864) along the South Section line of Sections Thirty-three (33) and Thirty-four (34), Township Eighty-seven (87), Range Twelve (12), in a somewhat irregular course, and along the West and South sides of the North one-half of the North East quarter of Section Three (3), Township Eighty-seven (87), Range Twelve (12).

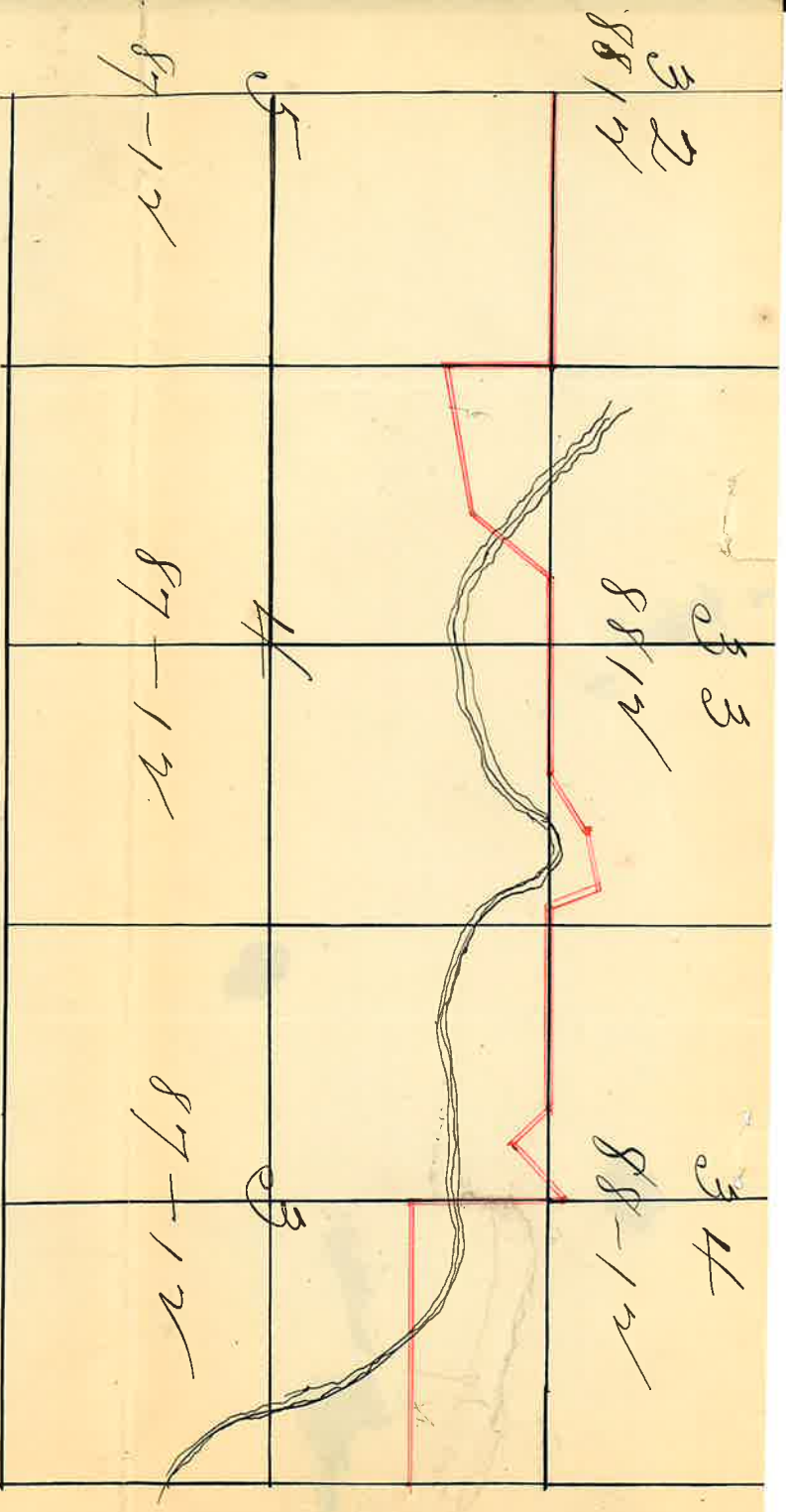
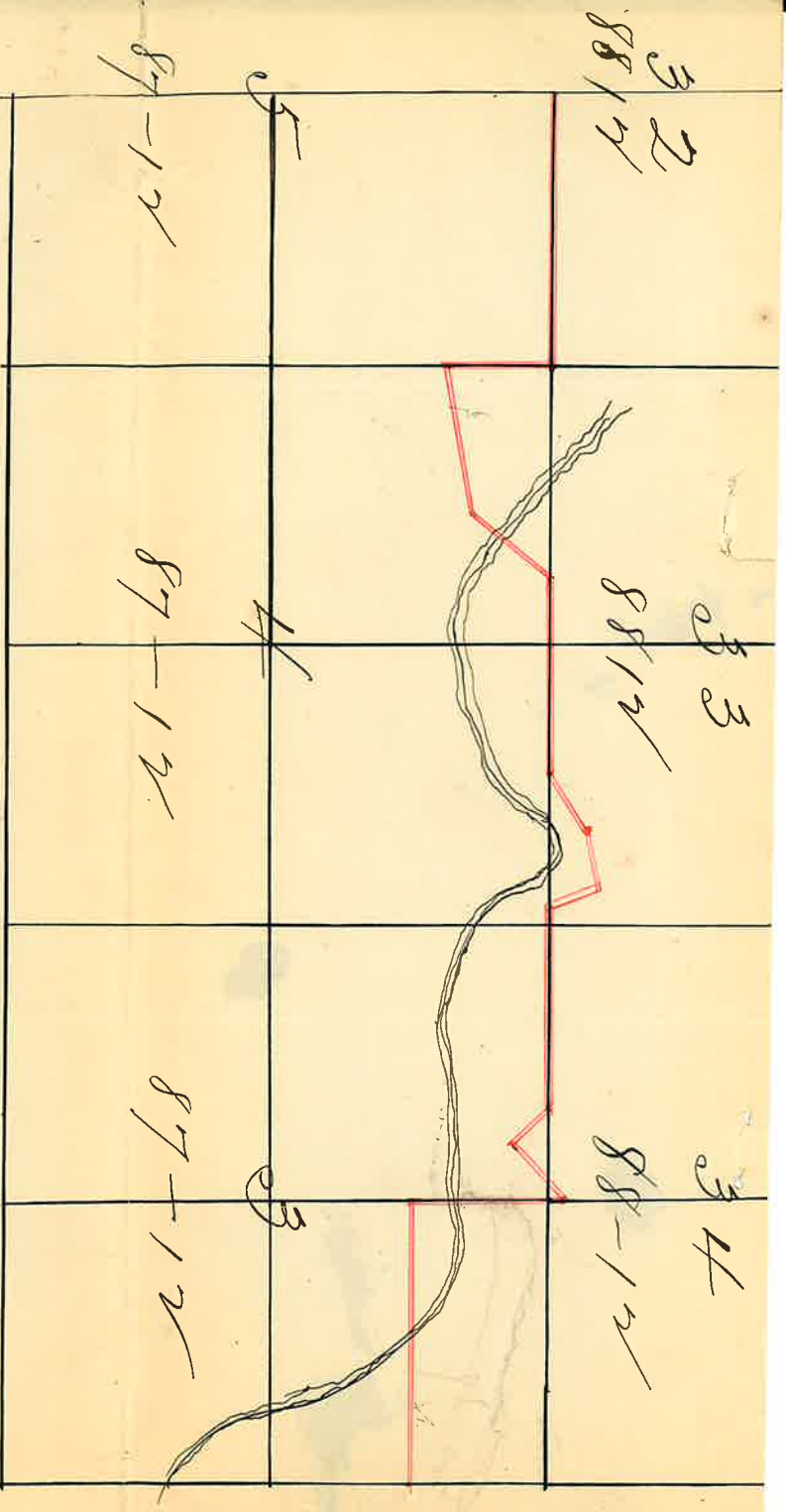
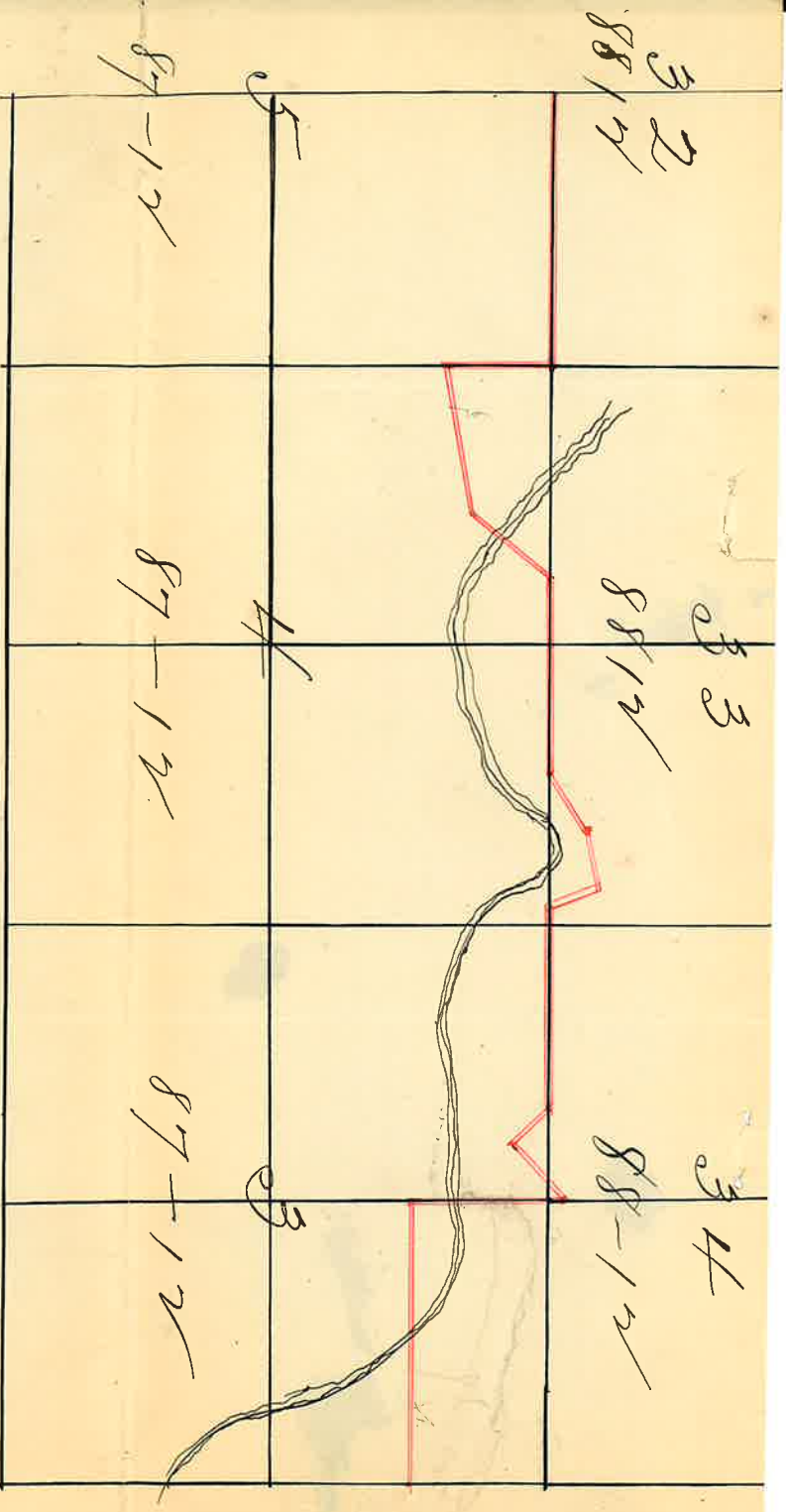
That your petitioner resides in the South East corner adjoining said highway of the North one-half of the North East quarter of said Section Three (3). That said highway is not open to the public, and your petitioner has no road cut from his residence; that said highway is fenced up by the owners of adjoining property.

The petitioner further shows that by a slight change in said established highway, it would not be necessary to build ^{an expensive} a bridge across Miller's Creek where said highway crosses said Creek.

WHEREFORE, your petitioner prays that either said highway be opened to the public as now located, and that a bridge be erected over Miller's Creek upon said highway, or that a Commissioner be appointed to examine into the expediency of the alteration of the aforesaid highway, so that a bridge would not be necessary.

Your petitioner attaches hereto a plat of said highway as shown by the records in the Auditor's office of this County.
