

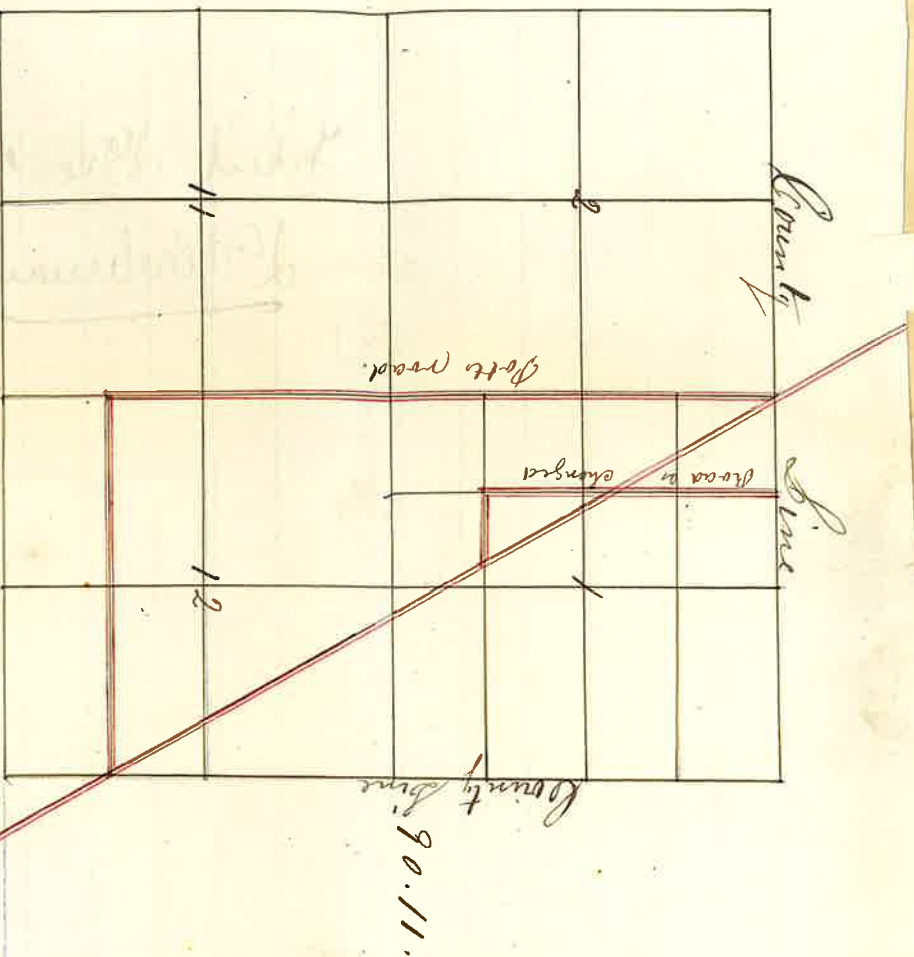

There is a plat of a change petition for the
 section shown & often in the Independent State road
 in sections no. 1 & 12 in S. 90. & 11 west in the County of
 Black Hawk & State of Iowa. I would recommend the location
 & discontinuance of that portion of said State road, that is situated
 between the East section line of Sec. 12 and the N. W. corner of section no. 1 in
 said Township & range. Also the change as formerly made in section no. 1 in
 said road as follows to wit, commencing at the N. E. corner of the S. E. 1/4 of Sec.
 12. thence running West to the West line of said section thence intersecting the road known
 as the Post road, thence running north to the County line for the following reasons
 1st The road as now located is not of sufficient importance to warrant the
 County paying the enormous high damages awarded the owners of the land said road
 crosses, 2nd The road if changed will give the West of the travelling community
 full access to the old road & the ground for a road in for disportion & turn on lines &
 not diagonally through ~~the~~ the lands of Crocker.

-pose of designating all of that portion of the Independence
and Washington State Road that is situated in the County
between North and North West of the North ~~East~~ corner
of the South East fourth of the South East fourth of section
(12) Township 19N North of Range 11W west and the same
to be relocated as follows to commence at the first a-
bove designated point from thence running due west
on the Eighth Rod line through ^{the} South half of section
(12) to west line of said ^{Section} intersect the 6th Road &
from thence North on said Road to the North
line of Black Hawk County then to terminate at the
same point of the State Road above mentioned
Dexter April the 22nd 1863

We now all Men by these presents that we Andrew-
Elcott
County of Blackhawk and State of Iowa and
held and firmly bound unto the County of
Blackhawk in the sum of one thousand dollars
for the payment of which well and truly to be
made we bind ourselves our heirs executors admin-
istrators and every of them firmly by these
presents.

The condition of the above obligation
is such that whereas Andrew Elcott
~~petitioner~~ has this day made appli-
cation by petition to the County Board of Super-
visors of said County for appointment a commissioner to
~~select~~ view and take up and locate certain
portion of the Independent and New Hamp-
shire State Road Now if the said Road shall
be established according to law and the same become
a public highway, and accordance with the statutes in
such cases made and provided then this obligation
to be void otherwise to be and remain in full
force and virtue
