



are to a plot of a charge petitioned for by
J. S. Parker, Horner & others in the Independent State road
in sections Nos. 1 & 12 in T. 90. R. 19 just in the County of
Black Hawk & State of Iowa. I would recommend the location
& dimensions of the portion of said state road, that is situated
between the east section line of sec. 12 and the cr. N. corner of section no. one in
said township & range. Also the change as formerly made in section line one, and now
said road as follows, to wit, commencing at the cr. E, corner of the S. 1/4 of sec.
12, thence running west to the west line of said section line intersecting the road known
as the Potow road, thence running north to the County line from the following reason,
that the road as now located is out of sufficient importance to warrant the
County, paying the enormous high damage awarded the owners of the land passed
over, 2nd. The road is charged full with the weight of the travelling community
full as well as the old road & the ground for a road is far superior & more convenient &
not diagonally through the lands, as before.

Be it known by the undersigned jointly to present to your comit
at the regular meeting of your county
certain a remonstance against all of that portion of the
Independence and New Hampton State Road that is sit-
uated in the County aforesaid North and South West of
the North East corner of the South East fourth of the South
East fourth of Section No 2 Township (90) North of Range (11)
First That whereas there is a road laid down by said residents
of the County aforesaid in consequence of said inhabitants pur-
suing never been any thing done in repairing or maintaining the
said road we claim it a nuisance and damage to the
County of Black Hawk and also to the Township of Linn
situated as it now is. and we would petition your hon-
able body that the same be taken in by our district as
relocated as follows To commence at the point where
designated and run thence due West on the Eighty second
line through South half of Section No 2 above described to
the west line of said section there to intersect the Forty
Road and thence north on said road to the North line
of said county at which point the above named state road
terminates, and we further ask that a Commissioner be ap-
pointed and sent to establish said road at the expence of
the County as we concider it will be beneficial to the same
and also to the community Yours truly

Notice is hereby given that there will be a petition presented to the Board of Supervisors of Black Hawk County at their regular meeting in June next for the purpose of disannulling all of that portion of the independence and New Hampshire State Road that is situated in the County of Black Hawk North and North West of the North ~~East~~ corner of the South East fourth of the South East fourth of section No. Township 90th North of Range 4th West and the same to be Relocated as follows to commence at the first above designated point and from thence running due west on the Eighty Road line through ^{the} South half obstruction to west line of said Road to the North from thence North on said Road to the North line of Black Hawk County then to terminate at the same point of the State Road above mentioned Lester off April the 22nd. 1863

as we are now too poor to afford
us money to pay our expenses
and we are in great want of money

I know all men by these presents that we Andrew
Elliott

County of Black Hawk and State of Iowa are
held and firmly bound unto the County of
Black Hawk in the sum of One Hundred Dollars
for the payment of which well and truly to be
Made we bind ourselves our heirs executors admin-
istrators and every of them firmly by these
present.

The condition of the above obligation
is such that whereas Andrew Elliott

~~has~~ has this day made application
to the County Board of Super-
visors of said County to appoint a commission to
~~take~~ view and take up and rebord's certain
portion of the Independence and New Hamp-
shire State Road near if the said Road shall
be established according to law and the same become
a public highway in accordance with the Statutes in
such cases made and provided then this obligation
to be void otherwise to be and remain in full
force and virtue
