

The undersigned Commissioner appointed by the Board of Supervisors of Said County on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of May 1864 to examine and report upon the following proposed route for a County Road (to commence at the South East corner of the North East 1/4 of Section No 14 Town & Range 1st Meridian Southwesterly to the South East corner of Section 4 in 30 in said Town & Range Meridian South to the South line of said Township to a point where the Road would intersect the Road from Grundy Center) respectfully make the following report that after being duly sworn I personally examined the route proposed for said road commencing on the day named for the commencement thereof in said commission and that in my opinion it is necessary and proper to lay out the proposed road on the following route as laid down on the Survey on the opposite side hereof.

Said that you have been appointed a Commissioner to view, and if necessary to lay off, the County Road, petitioned for by John F. Hamm, Road petitioned for, is

You will, therefore, appear at the Office of Q. Master Publ. in  
 said County, on the 13<sup>rd</sup> day of May A.D. 1864, at 8 o'clock  
 A.M., and qualify according to Law, and proceed immediately to the discharge of your duty  
 and make your report thereon according to Law and the following Instructions, on or before  
 the next term of this Court:

1. In your survey of this Road you will particularly describe the point of commencement, with reference to some and distance from some one of which, you must give in your field notes.
2. You must also measure to, and in your field notes return the distance to some section or quarter section corner, from the point at which you terminate your survey must be ascertained and returned by reference to the same evidence as is herein required for the commencing point.
3. The letters and figures inscribed upon wood must be cut with a "marking iron," similar to that used in the government survey of bearing trees.
4. All hauls, without fail, should be cut the initial letters of the points of beginning and ending of the Road a Road from Lance to Cascade: D. & C. R. When bearing trees cannot be had at angles, it is recommended that the bearing and distance should be raised at the point of the angle.
5. Marks in timber will consist of a smooth blaze with a "notch in the center, except where the wood is green or wet, must have three notches, both upon the side when the line strikes and that upon which detection of all errors, either in your chaining or course.
6. Before commencing your survey you must compare and adjust your chain to a standard key this office.
7. After completing your survey of this Road you must carefully protract the same upon paper.
8. These Instructions in no way relieve you from each and every duty prescribed by the laws or rules, pages 91 and 92.
9. Your compass must be adjusted to run upon the true medium; that is, the true magnetic variation only must be employed, and this must invariably be stated, and all changes, as a part of the field notes of this survey.
