Your petitioners owning and occupying of
lands in Union Township in said County would
very truly represent to your Hon Body that a
road is now located in said Township commencing
at a point 40 rods east of the center of section
29, Township 90 Range 14, and running east and
intersecting the road from Cedar Valley to Shellbrook -
That said road as now located is not located
in a straight line, nor is nearly straight as
the same might be. - That as now located the
road is ^{of} much greater length than is necessary
and does not accommodate the public to the
extent that a road at that point should -
Your petitioners therefore pray that commissioners
may be appointed to relocate and designate
said road and place the same upon more
suitable ground -
