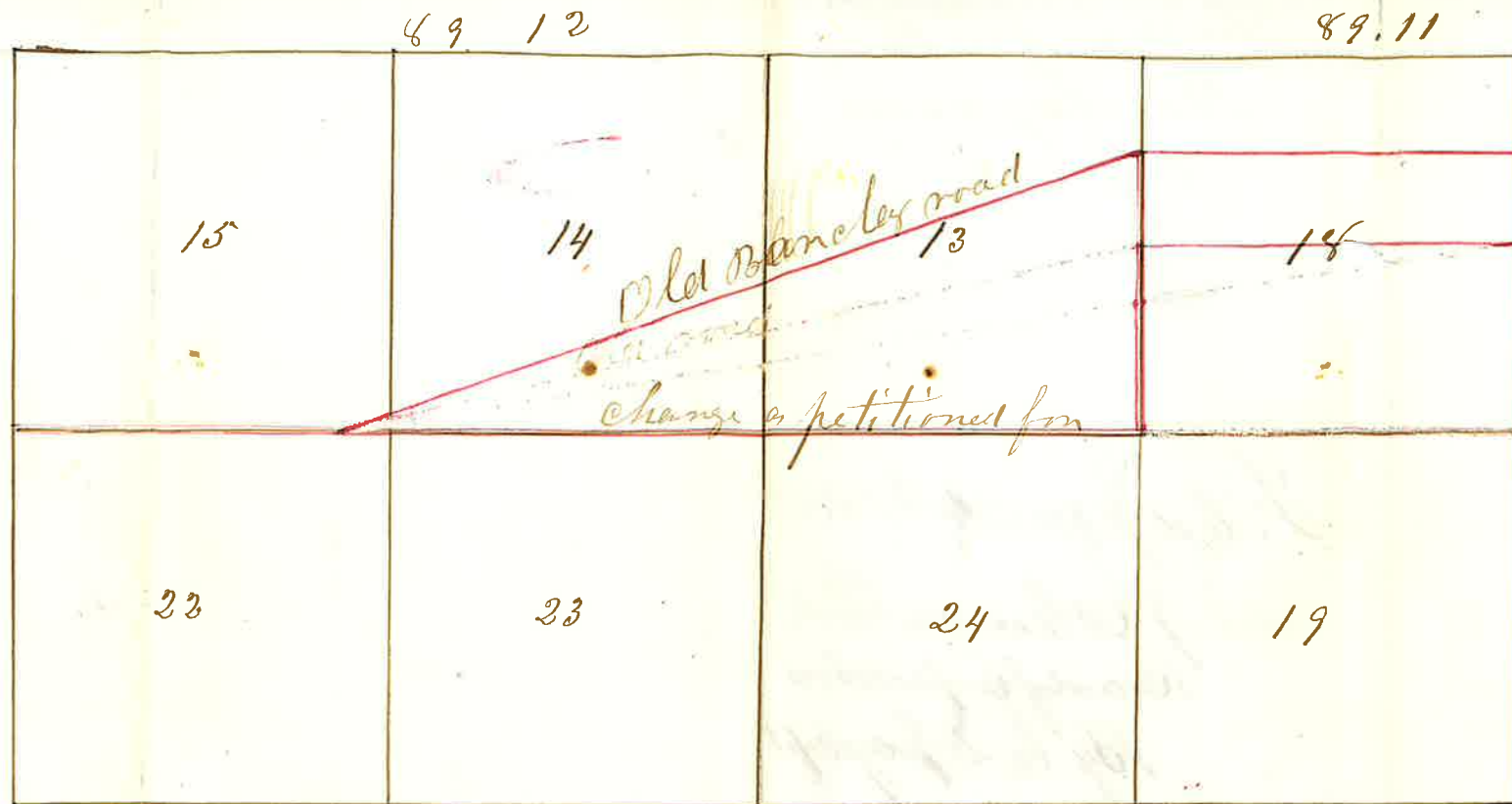

The above is a plot of the change petitioned for by J. H. Seavitt and others in the Waterloo & Baneley road, Black Hawk County and State of Iowa. Said change commences at the north west corner of the South half of the north west quarter of sec. 18. & 89 & 11 west, then a running south to south west corner of said sec. no. 18. thence west on section line until it intersects said road as before located. The old road runs diagonally through lands that are now being improved and is very detrimental to the land. The ground for a road on new route is far superior to that of the old. I would therefore recommend the change as herein set forth and that that portion of said Baneley road running diagonally through sections no. 13, 14 & 15 be discontinued.

 Dollars, for the payment of which we bind ourselves, our executors and administrators,
 jointly and severally.

Whereas, an application has been made to the Board of Supervisors of
Blackhawk County, for the establishment of a State road, as
 follows:

Now if the said

shall pay all expenses which may accrue in the location of said road, in case the same
 shall not be established a public highway, then this bond to be void, otherwise to remain
 in full force and effect.
