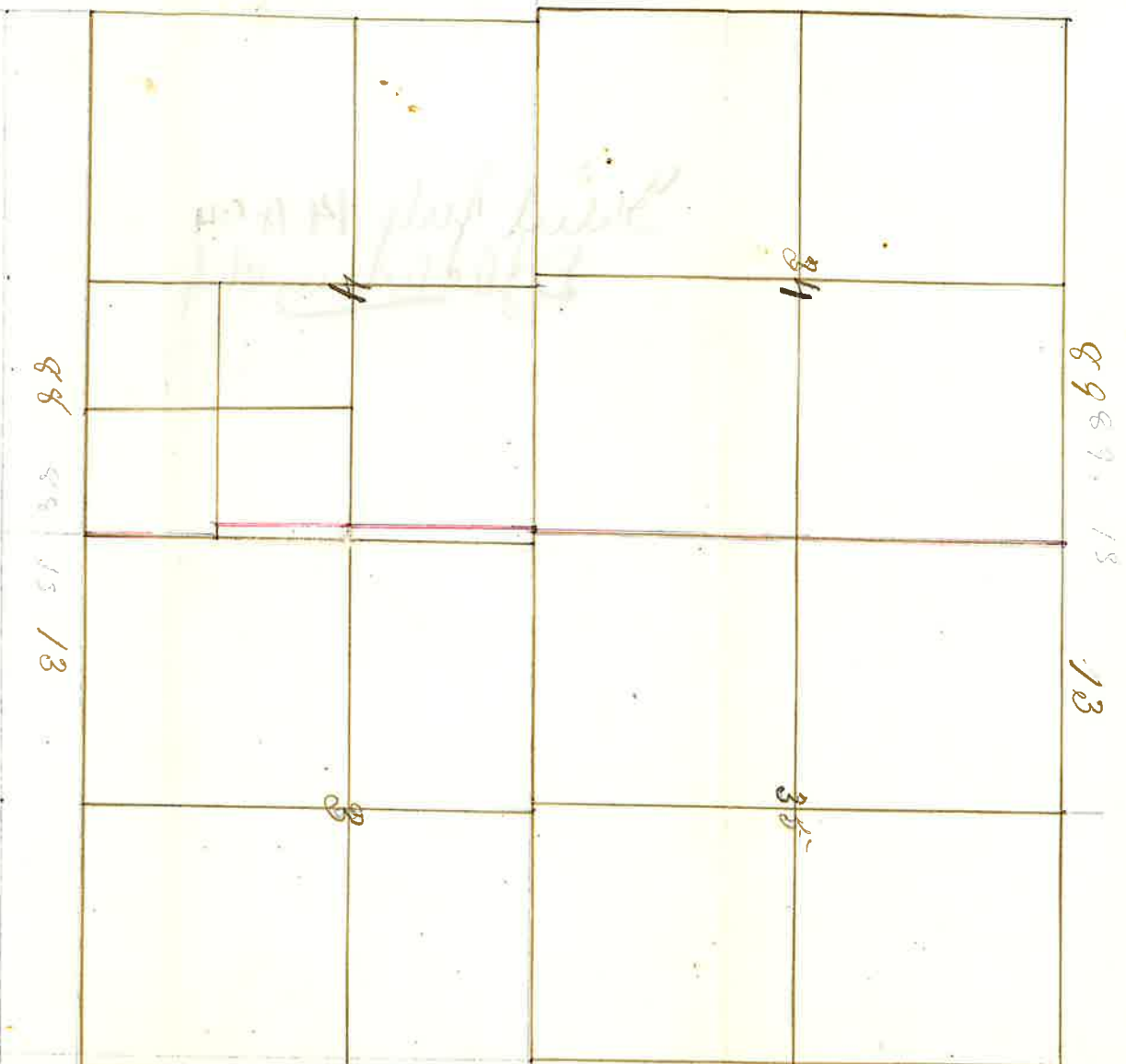

Notice is hereby given that there will be a petition presented
to the Board of Supervisors of Black Hawk County Iowa
On the 1st Monday of June 1864 asking the approval
of a Commissioner to determine into the propriety
of making a change in the Des Moines Co. road &
follow to wit: Commencing on the correction line at
the point where the road running south intersects
said correction line, then running west to the line
between lands now owned by Daniel Schell
and John Berhart, then running south to
a point west of the corner of the corner of sec 2.2 88.13, then east to the
section line and repeat upon the same May 7 /64

Remun all men by their parents that
we cannot all children in debt
and firmly bound unto the County of Black
Stam that of law in the named sum
of one hundred dollars for the payment of
which we bind ourselves & legal representatives
whereof we are to make & other their
Applics to the Board of Supervision of
Black Stanch County for a charge of
the same County fees immediately South of
the Commissioning fees as it first in
making Application

Now if the said petitioners shall pay
all expenses growing out of the Application for
said charge the said obligation shall
be done otherwise to remain in full force
& effect
