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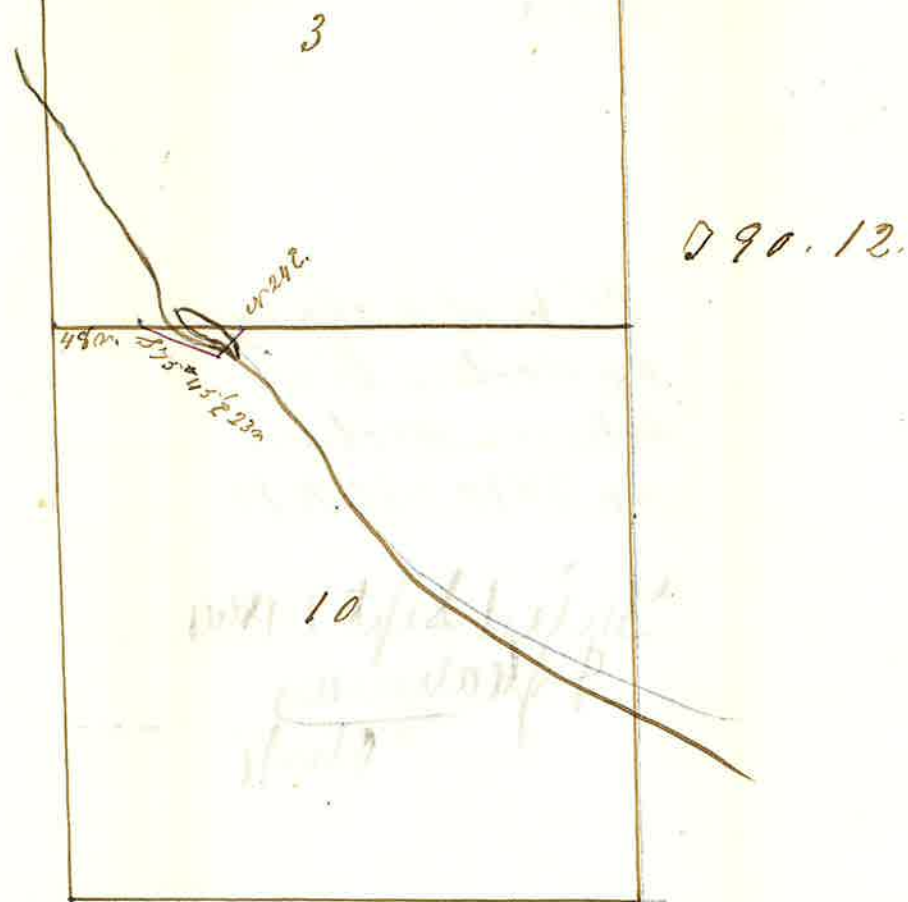

shall not be established a public highway, then this bond to be void, otherwise to remain
in full force and effect.
