County Iowa for the establishment of
a County Road describe as follows

No 14 in Litch Township running
thence west on the section line to the
North West corner of Section No 18 in
Litch Township

Now if said petitioners shall pay all the
expenses growing out of the application for
said Road whether the same shall be
established or not this obligation shall
be void otherwise remain in full force
and effect
