Our Petitioners

Citizens of said County of Alameda would
wound and perpetually refuse it that there
is now a County road running from the
West line of section No. 36 in Township No.
Eight mile (33) North of Range No. 12 West of
8th 11th P.M. on the half section line of said section
No. 35. Eight rods East on said half section
line thence at right angles with said half
section line North to the North line of said
section No. 36 to another County road running
East West. Our Petitioners affirm that the road
running North from said half section line East
mentioned is unnecessary and inconvenient, but that
a road is much needed from the point where said
last mentioned road angles running East on said
half section line to the East line of said section No. 35
thence South on the East line of said section one
half mile to the Hilys of Raymond, and also North
on the East line of said section one half mile to
the North East corner of said section to intersect
a road running East West on the North line of
said section. Our Petitioners would therefore
ask that the road beginning eight rods East of the
West line of section No. 35 on the half section line of
said section running North to the North line
of said section be vacated, and that a County

road be established, beginning at the point
on said half section line eighty rods east
of the West line of said section 17. 35' summit
on said half section line & the East line of
said section, hence at right angles running
South on the East line of said section & the
hills of Laymond, and also North on the
East line of said section & the North
East corner of said section 17. 35'

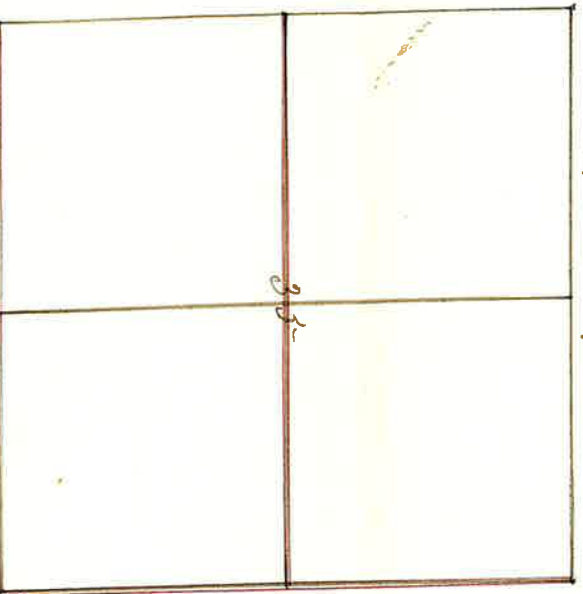
