KNOW ALL MEN, by these Presents, That we, Stephen Evans  
John W. Pinerson, Henry Gipe Jr, Major Rice, James Leinenbender & others  
of the county of Black Hawk, and State of Iowa, are held and firmly bound unto the county  
of Blackhawk in the sum of one hundred dollars  
for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, ad  
ministrators, and every of them, firmly, by these presents.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such, That, whereas the said  
obligors have this day made application, by petition, to the  
County Court of said county, to appoint a commissioner to view and locate a county road, called  
The County line and Spring creek road

Now, if the said road shall be established according to law, and the same become a public  
highway, in accordance with the statute in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be  
void: otherwise, to be and remain in full force and virtue.

Having been authorized by the Judge of Black  
Hawk County on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of January D 1854  
to locate a County Road from the East line of the  
County at the center of Section 25 T 87 N R 11 W  
to cross the Cedar River at the mouth of Spring Creek  
thence to the South line of the County. To be called the  
County line & Spring Creek road; and having in accor-  
dance therewith on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of ~~December~~<sup>January</sup> 1854 proceed-  
ed to examine the route of said road and having found  
such road necessary and also the ground to be suitable  
I have therefore located said road in manner following

Commencing at the East line of the County  
at the center of Sec 25 T 87 N Range 11 W. Thence West through  
the center of said Sec. to the West line of said Sec., one mile  
thence South on line between Sec 25 & 26 one half mile to the  
South East corner of Sec 26. Thence West on South line of said  
Sec 26, three fourths of a mile to the mouth of Spring Creek and  
thence South on a line parallel with the section line one mile  
to the South line of the County January 30<sup>th</sup> 1854

South to the South line of said Township; and others, commencing at the S. W. corner of Section thirty five, Township eighty seven, Range thirteen, thence running North, following Section lines to the village of Waterloo;

The Road petitioned for by Michael Bunting and others, commencing at the N. W. corner of Section ten, Township eighty seven, Range twelve, thence South, following Section lines to the S. W. corner of Section thirty four, in said Township;

The Road petitioned for by Velorious Thomas and others, commencing at the S. W. corner of Section eleven, Township ninety, Range fourteen, thence east on Section lines to the east line of said Township;

And the road petitioned for by Morrison Bailey and others, commencing at the N. E. corner of Section fourteen, Township eighty nine, Range thirteen, thence West on Section lines to N. E. corner of Section sixteen, thence South on Section line forty rods, thence West eighty rods, thence North forty rods to the line of Section sixteen, thence West on said line to the bank of Cedar River, thence in a westerly course along said bank, until it again intersects the line of said Section sixteen, thence west along said line to the bank of said river, have been platted by order of the County Court of said County, and the plats and field-notes thereof filed in the office of the County Judge, and that at the July Term of said Court A. D. 1859, unless good cause be shown to the contrary, the said County Court will approve said plats and order that they be severally recorded, as in case of the original establishment of Public Highways, according to Chapter 130 of the Session Laws of 1859.

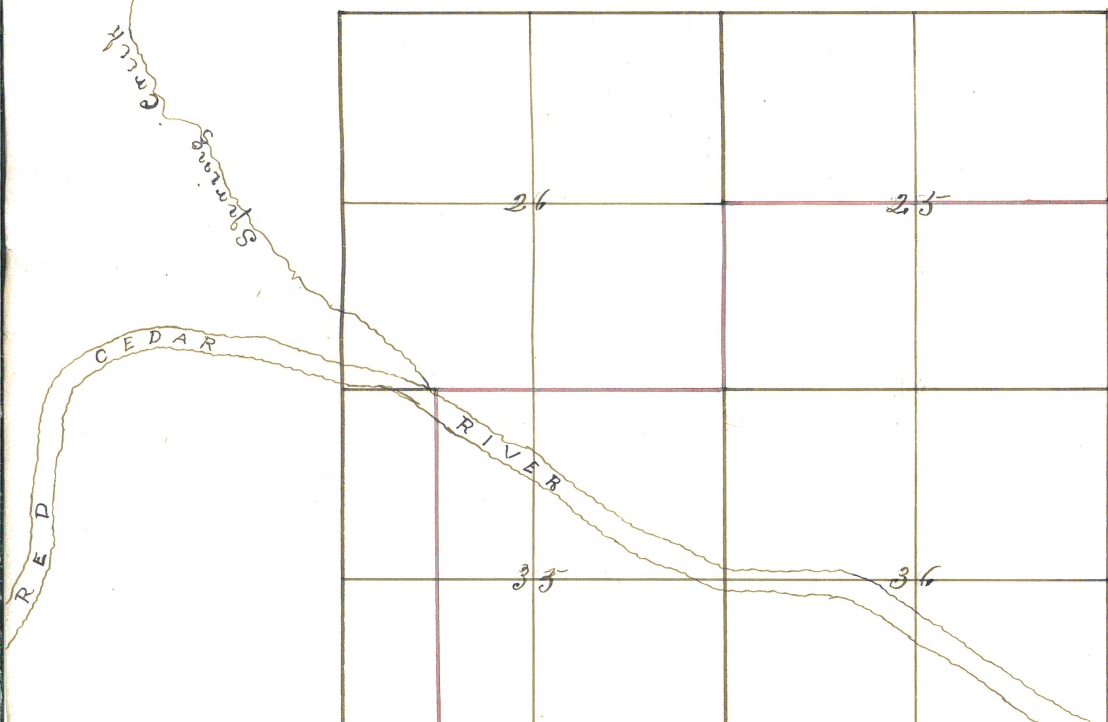
