Whereas, an application has been made to the Board of Supervisors of Black Hawk County, for ^{a charter} the establishment of a State road, as follows: Commencing at or near Joseph Shuman

Monroe Runway North 85-Road on line between sections 15- & 16 to the 1/4 mile cor'd Sec 15- & 16 Thence East- 1 1/2 rods intersecting the Leonas Valley, Road

Now if the said Leop Shuman

shall pay all expenses which may accrue in the location of said road, in case the same shall not be established a public highway, then this bond to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
