in June 1865 for the location of a road
commencing on the road leading from Webster
to Hampden in said county at a point
where said road makes an angle or for the curve
in section 30 thirty two (32) Township 16 north
(59) range twelve (12) west of the fifth principal
Meridian thence running southeasterly and
along the east bank of the Cedar river
with the meanderings of said stream to the
section line between sections 31 and 32 Township
39 R 12 West thence south or in the section line
to ^{the} east bank of ^{the} said river between sections 31 and 32 & 12 & 13 sec 12
th 38 & 13 That said road is much needed
as a lumber road and we ask that a compromise
be appointed to view said road and that the same
may be established as a public highway

Now if the said Petitioners

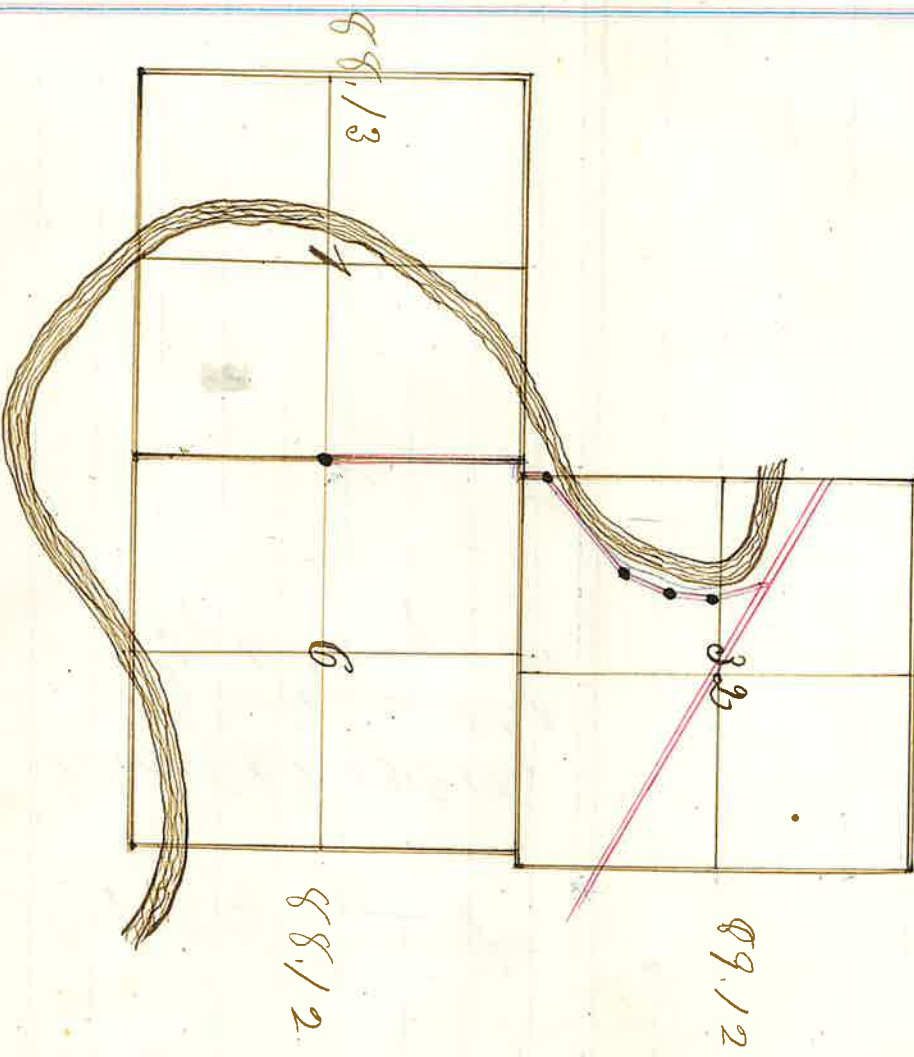
shall pay all expenses which may accrue in the location of said road, in case the same shall not be established a public highway, then this bond to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
