J J Leavitt & Francis A Bennett

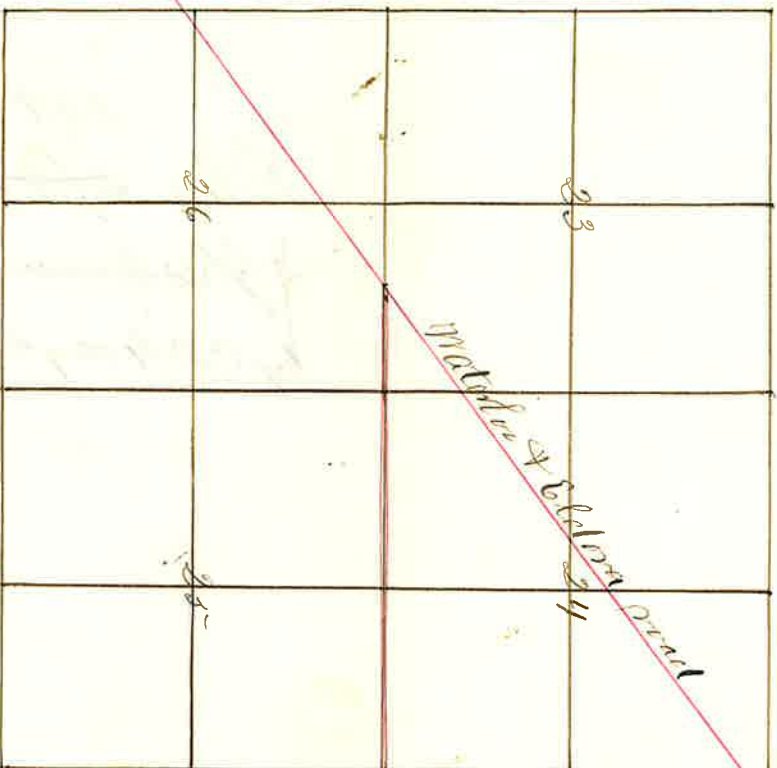
shall pay all expenses which may accrue in the location of said road, in case the same
shall not be established a public highway, then this bond to be void, otherwise to remain
in full force and effect.

To the Hon Grand Jury of Supervisors
of Bleas-Hawke County, State of Iowa,
Your Petitioners would
respectfully represent that a County
Road is established commencing at the
North East Corner of Sec. 25. Tp. 88. Range
14 west in said County and running
due east to ~~the~~ ^{the} Village of
Wilbertville; that there is no public high-
way on the west portion of said road
leading to or toward the Village of Mateler;
that the distance between the west end
of said Road and the Mateler & Cedar
Road is only about one or one quarter miles;
and that there are quite a large number of set-
tlers at or near the west end of said Road
leading to Wilbertville that share no public
roads leading to Mateler, or the Village of
Mateler which is situated within about two
miles and ^{containing} the nearest Post Office. We would
therefore most humbly ask that a Public
High Way may be established on the fol-
lowing line, to wit: Commencing at
the North East Corner of said Section
No. 25 Township No. 88. Range 14 west and
thence running directly west on the north

line of said section to the Elders & Mathews
Road.

Road Notice

There will be a petition presented to the Board of Supervisors of Black Hawk County, State of Iowa, on the 16 day of August A.D. 1865, asking for the appointment of a Commissioner to view and report upon the expediency of laying out a County road commencing at the North East Corner of ~~the~~ Section twenty five in Township No 88 - Range No. 14 West. and thence running directly west to the County Road known as the Waterloo and Eldora Road. Of which all persons interested will take notice, and govern themselves accordingly.
