Your petition,
James T. Pedersen, respectfully rep-
resents that he is a resident of
Mt Vernon Township of said Co.
and that and that he is the owner
of the North East Gr. of the Double West
Gr. and the North West Gr. of the South
East Gr. of Section Fifteen (15) Tp. 90.
South of Range Thirteen (13). That he
lives on and occupies said land &
has no road or out-let, whatever to
and from said land. He further
represents that the least expensive,
and only practical route for a
road to said land is as follows:-
viz; Commencing at a point, to wit;
the South West corner, running to
the South East corner of the North
West Gr. of the South West Gr. of
Sec Fifteen (15) Tp. 90. North of
Range (13) Thirteen, a plot of which
is hereto attached. Your petition
would also represent that the land
on each side of said proposed

Road is owned by different parties, and that the establishment of a Road of the same or less length, cannot be done, without crossing wet and swamp-land, and at very great expense. Your Petitioner further represents, that on the 18th and 20th of April, last past, (1863), he posted notice of an application on his part to have said road established and confirmed as a private way, and as required by law. Your Petitioner therefore respectfully asks that this Hon. Board will appoint a Commissioner, to examine, lay out and establish said Private Way - only two (2) rods in width, just as is provided for a wagon road. June 4th 1863

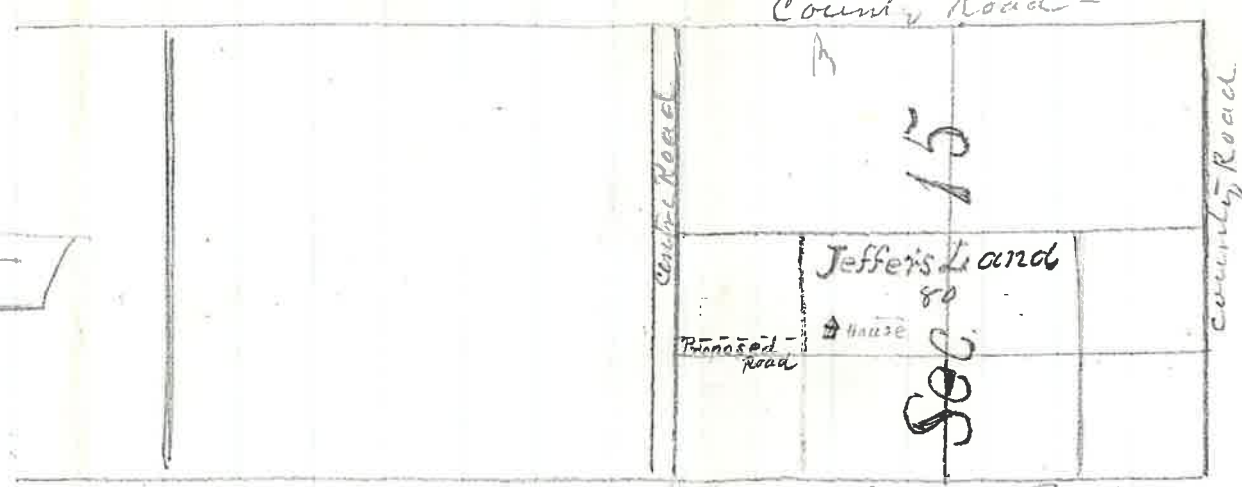

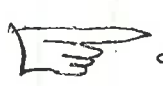

You are hereby notified that you have been appointed a Commissioner to view, and if expedient, to locate a ^{new} ~~county~~ road, petitioned for by *J. J. Jeffers* and others, and to be called the *Jeffers* Road,

described as follows:

Commencing at the *South West corner of the North West Quarter Section of the South West quarter of Sec. 19 T. 90 N. Range 13. Thence running east to the South East corner of the North West quarter of the South West quarter of Sec. 13 T. 90 N. Range 13. Thence*

You will, therefore, appear at the office of some Justice of the Peace, Notary Public, or Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, and qualify according to law; and on the *6th* day of *July* 18*68*, you will proceed to commence the examination of the route above described, and if, in your judgment, the above road is needed, or one in the vicinity answering the same purpose, you will call to your assistance the necessary aid, and proceed to lay out and mark the same according to law and the following instructions, and report to the Board on or before the *7th* day of *April* 18*68*.

1. In your survey of this road you will particularly describe the point of commencement, which will be generally found to consist of corners in the public and private surveys; the exact course and distance from some one of which you must give in your field notes.
2. The point at which you terminate your survey must be ascertained and returned by reference to the same evidence as is herein required for the commencing point.
3. All letters and figures inscribed upon wood, must be cut with a "marking iron," similar to that used in the Government survey of lands.
4. Where bearing trees are taken, (and it is strongly enjoined that it within ten rods of an angle, they should without fail be taken,) a smooth face from the angle of the road, should be made as near the ground as possible, and in this face should be cut the initial letters of the points of beginning and ending of the road. For example--a road from point A to point B, the bearing tree should be cut at angles, it is recommended the bearing and distance to it written, either "corner of the road" or "bearing tree" and where this is impracticable, a large mound of earth should be raised at the point of the angle.
5. Marks in timber with iron spikes, or "blazes," with a notch in the centre, except the trees with the line cuts, each of which must have three notches, both upon the set at the crossing of fences and streams, and at intervals in the prairie not exceeding one-fourth of a mile each, and the distance marked thereon. After completing your survey of this road, you must carefully provide the same upon paper, with a view to the detection of all errors, either in your chaining or course.
6. These instructions in no way relieve you from each and every duty prescribed by the laws of Iowa Revision of 1860, pages 124 and 125.
7. All your assistants are required to be sworn by some person authorized to administer oaths.
