trators and assigns of them, jointly by these presents.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas D.
H. Mitchell has this day made application to the Board of Super-
visors of said County to appoint a Commissioner to view and report
upon the location of a portion of the Cedar Falls and Des Moines
River road, that if the said D. H. Mitchell shall pay all
costs that may be adjudged against him by the Board of Super-
visors, in accordance with the Statute in such case made and
provided, then is that obligation to be void, otherwise to be and

You are hereby notified that you have been appointed a Commissioner to view, and if expedient, to ~~locate~~ ^{locate} a county road, petitioned for by W. H. Shilbush and others, and ~~to be~~ called the Cedar Falls & Beaver Grove Road, described as follows: That portion of said road that

described as follows:

Commencing at the lies in section Three Townships
Eighty nine Range, Southern, Salt River
commencing at a point near the south east
corner and terminating at a point near
the south west corner of said section
then south eighty nine Range Southern

You will, therefore, appear at the office of some Justice of the Peace, Notary Public, or Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, and qualify according to law; and on the 10th day of December 1868, you will proceed to commence the examination of the route above described, and if, in your judgment, the above road is needed, or one in the vicinity answering the same purpose, you will call to your assistance the necessary aid, and proceed to lay out and mark the same according to law and the following instructions, and report to the Board on or before the 10th day of March 1868.

1. In your survey of this road you will particularly describe the point of commencement, with reference to some known cut record, which will be generally found to consist of corners in the public and private surveys - the exact course and distance from some one of which you must give in your field notes.
2. The point at which you terminate your survey must be ascertained and returned by reference to the same evidence as is herein required for the commencement point.
3. All letters and figures inscribed upon wood, or cut with a "marking iron," similar to that used in the Government survey of lands.
4. Where bearing trees are taken, and it is strongly enjoined that it within ten chains of an angle, they should without fail be taken, a smooth tree, fronting the angle of the road, should be marked as I, preferable, and in this case should be cut the initial letters of the points of beginning and ending of the road. For example—a road in Henry—D. & C. R. When bearing trees cannot be had at angles, it is recommended that the angle distance to a boundary, either, or corner of an enclosure be taken, and where this is impracticable, a large mound of earth should be placed at the point of the angle.
5. Marks in timber will consist of a small "blaze," with a notch in the centre, except the trees with the line cuts, each of which must have three notches, both upon the side which the line strikes, and front upon which it crosses such trees. All points must be set up at every mile, and the distance marked thereon.
6. Slakes must be set at the crossing of fences and struts, and at intervals in the prairie not exceeding one-fourth of a mile each.
7. After completing your survey of this road, you must carefully protect the same upon paper, with a view to the detection of all errors, either in your chaining or course.
8. These instructions in no way relieve you from each and every duty prescribed by the laws of Iowa Revision of 1850, pages 134 and 135.
9. All your assistants are required to be sworn by some person authorized to administer oaths.
