Know all Men by these Presents, That we, _____, of the County of Blackhawk and State of Iowa, are held and firmly bound unto the State for the use of Blackhawk County, in the sum of \$1000 dollars, for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, and every one of them, firmly by these presents.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas C. H. Rose has this day made application by petition to the Board of Supervisors of said County, to appoint a Commissioner to view and locate a road, to be called Black Hawk Road,

Now, if said C. H. Rose shall pay all costs that may be adjudged against him by the Board of Supervisors, in accordance with the statute in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.
