between the North & Next to the north tier of
sections to the east line of said Township
And that so much of said Road heretofore
laid out between said extremities of said road
be vacated and we the undersigned do hereby
grant the right of way for said road

The undersigned Commissioners appointed by the General assembly of Iowa at their sep. conv. 1852, 3, to locate & establish a State road from Camp creek in the county of Buchanan, via Barrick's Ford in Bremer County to intersect a State road from Cedar Falls in Black Hawk Co. to Clear Lake in Cerro Gordo County.

Would respectfully report that we met at Camp creek in Buchanan Co. on Monday the 11th day of July 1853. and proceeded to locate said road, as shown by the accompanying plat and field notes of said road as per report of Surveyor.

And we certify that the table contained upon said plat shows correctly the names of persons, & time each was employed on said road - also, the amounts due each from the respective Counties through which said road passes.

To the County Court of Blackhawk County I
here with transmit to you my Report as
follows

I have located a road to be
known by the name of Big Woods road
commencing at the South East Corner of
1st Town 890 Range 14 west then running N
to the town line to the N E Corner
of said Town whole Length 6 Miles
also a road to be known by the name
of the South Township line Road of
2nd said Township 90 R 14. Commencing at the
S E corner of said Town 90 R 14 and
thence running West - 6 Miles to the S W
Corner of said Township

3rd Also a road commencing on the Bremer
County line between Sec^s one & two thence
running South on said line five Miles $\frac{1}{2}$
to be known ^{by the name} by Barrack's road

also commencing on the South line of said
Township 90 R 14 at the center ~~to~~ line of
Sec 33 thence running North on said center
line $4\frac{1}{2}$ Miles to the center of Sec 9 of
4th said Township to be known thence
west on a straight West $2\frac{1}{2}$ Miles to
the line of Butler County to be
known by the name of Beaver
Creek & West fork road

5th Also a Road commencing at the ~~center~~ S, E. corner
of Sec 16 in said Township running East three
Miles to intersect said big Woods Road
to be known as the Center township Road

also Road commencing at the South East
Corner sec 27 in said Township running North
6th three and one half Miles on said line to the
Corner of Helms land, thence East one and
one fourth mile to the Berriett Road
to be called the Youngs Road

also a road commencing one half mile
West ^{from S. E. Corner of sec 27} thence running North 134 Rods thence
7th West one mile
and thence to the center of sec 35 in said
Township thence on said center section line
one and three fourths mile West to Cullen River

also a road commencing Eighty Rods
8th North of the South East Corner of sec 27 in
said Township, thence East one mile to inter-
sect the Berriett Road

also a Road commencing at the center
9th of sec three in said Township on the Bremer
County line thence South one and three fourths
miles thence East one half mile to intersect
a road called the Youngs Road

the undersigned your Commissioner Reports
that he has obtained by consent from the
owners of land through which the above
named Roads are surveyed the right of
way to be free — Benjamin Knapp Com.
