ourselves, and our executors and
administrators, jointly and severally.

Whereas John S. Halley & B. Kelly
have applied to the Board of Supervisors
of Black Hawk County, Iowa, for
the establishment of a county road
described as follows: Commencing
on section line, between sections 35 & 36
at the South end of Lincoln Township,
and thence running North on said
section line to Jockeytown School House.
Now, if said petitioners shall pay all the
expenses growing out of the application
for said road, if it shall not be established
by said Board, the above obligation shall be
void; otherwise to remain in full force
and effect.
