the Blackhawk road a road, to be called High Street in the town of Waterloo
or High Street in the town of Waterloo and all in the township of
Waterloo in the county of Black Hawk

may be adjudged against him by the Board of Supervisors, in accordance with the statute in such
cases made and provided, then this obligation to be void, otherwise to be and remain in full force
and virtue.
