Remonstrance.

To the Hon. the Board of Supervisors for Black Hawk County, Iowa.

The undersigned owners of property and citizens of Big Creek Township, Black Hawk County, Iowa, having learned, that application will be made to your honorable Board for the appointment of a Commissioner

to examine and report upon the expediency of laying out and establishing a County Road in said Township, designated and described in the public Notice as follows, to wit:

"Beginning at the Quarter Section Post on the Section Line between Sections 26 and 27, Township of Range 12, thence

~~westward~~ ~~southward~~ to the Quarter Section Post on the Section line between Sections 25 and 36; thence on the Quarter Section line in Section 25 until it intersects the State Road leading from Cedar Rapids to Cedar Falls in said Township,"

be it more respectfully yet earnestly to Remonstrate against the establishment of said Road, for these reasons, among others that might be urged: The said Road as designated, has

no direct connection with any public Road now opened; it is located upon quarter section lines; it will entail upon the owners of lands bordering thereon, heavy expenses for fencing the boundaries that the character of the ground on which the same must pass, is ill adapted for a public highway, being hilly and marshy, and will be a heavy burden to the Township to make and keep the same in repair. — We would however most

cheerfully assent to the establishing of a Road (one that will fully answer all the requirements of public convenience) — as follows: To commence at the West point of the section line between Sections 25 and 26, and thence continuing along the said line East to the before mentioned State Road. — This line would be a continuation of a road already established and open extending some miles Westward, and would be quite nearly half a mile shorter than the point of starting, to the

State Road herein mentioned than that petitioned for, and can be put in travelling order and so kept, at much less expense to the Township — A considerable portion of the line herein recommended, has by contiguous owners of the lands bordering theron, been for many years allowed to be used as, and for a highway, and little or no injury would be sustained by any one of its extension to the State Road as herein suggested.

That the remonstrance and the suggestions herein made may meet the due consideration of your Honorable Board. Your Remonstrants will ever pray the

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, R. J. McQuilkin and G. W. Dickinson, of the County of Blackhawk and State of Iowa, are held and firmly bound unto the State for the use of Blackhawk County, in the sum of Fifty dollars, for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, and every one of them, firmly by these presents.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas R. J. McQuilkin ~~said~~ has this day made application by petition to the Board of Supervisors of said County, to appoint a Commissioner to view and locate a road, to be called McQuilkin Road.

Now, if said R. J. McQuilkin shall pay all costs that may be adjudged against him by the Board of Supervisors, in accordance with the statute in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.
