The undersigned, having been appointed a Commissioner to view, and, if thought necessary, locate a certain Road in said County, petitioned for by W. B. Burnham and others, and known as the Burnham Road, would report as follows :

That, having been duly sworn, he found, upon examination, that it was expedient and necessary, for the accommodation of the public, that the road should be located as petitioned for.

Therefore, with the assistance of Angus J. Johnson as witness, W. B. Burnham as chairman, and Frank Burnham as assessors, who were all duly sworn, your Commissioner proceeded on the day set therefore, to-wit: the 22^d day of March A. D. 1887, to lay out and locate said Road, and to distinguish the same by the proper marks, mounds, and stakes, in the manner prescribed by law, and in accordance with the Field Notes and Plat of Survey of the Road, which are herewith annexed, and which are made part of this report.

Your Commissioner is of the opinion, that the road will be of great convenience and utility to the public, and would hereby recommend its establishment.

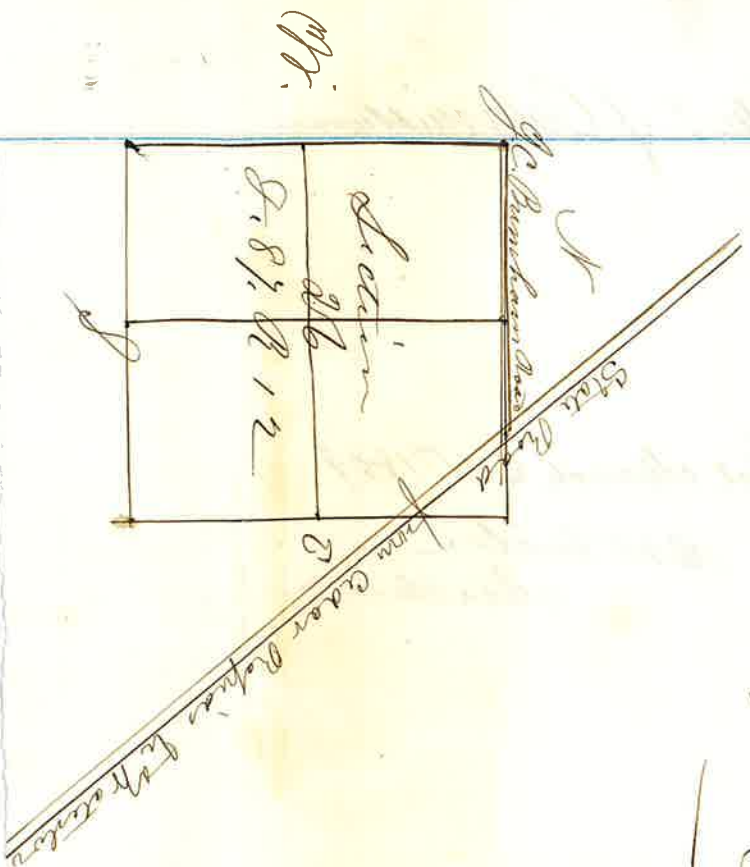
