

You are hereby notified that you have been appointed a Commissioner to view, and if expedient, to locate a county road, petitioned for by J. Langman and others, and to be called the Langman Road..... Road, described as follows:

Commencing at the Waukesha & Eldora Road on the Section Line between Sections Seven & Eight and Eighteen (18) and North Eighty-Eighth (88) Range thirteen miles west of the South East corner of Sec. Eleven (11) North Eighty-Eighth Range on the South West corner of the East half of the South East quarter of Section Eleven (11) thence west to the South West corner of the South East half of the South East quarter of Section Eighteen (18) North Eighty-Eighth Range of Franklin Co. Iowa and proceed to lay out and mark the same according to law

You will, therefore, appear at the office of some Justice of the Peace, Notary Public, or Clerk of

the Board of Supervisors, and qualify according to law; and on the 15th day of March 1869, you will proceed to commence the examination of the route above described, and if, in your judgement, the above road is needed, or one in the vicinity answering the same purpose, you will call to your assistance the necessary aid, and proceed to lay out and mark the same according to law and the following instructions, and report to the Board on or before the 22nd day of March

1. In your survey of this road you will particularly describe the point of commencement, with reference to some monument record, which will be generally found to consist of cones in the public and private surveys; the exact course and distance from some one of which you must give in your field notes.
2. The point at which you terminate your survey must be ascertained and uniformly known to the same violence as is herein required for the commencing point.
3. All letters and figures inscribed upon wood, must be cut with a "marking iron," similar to that used in the Government survey of lands.
4. Where bearing trees are taken, (and it is strongly enjoined that it will be ten chains of an angle, they should without fail be taken,) a smooth face fronting the angle of the road, should be made as near the ground as practicable, and in this face should be cut the initial letters of the points of beginning and ending of the road. For example—out in on Delia to Calico—D. & C. K. W. in bearing trees cannot be had at angles, it is recommended the bearing and distance to a boundary, eddy, or corner of an enclosure, be taken, and where this is impracticable, a large mound of earth should be raised at the joint of the angle.
5. Marks in timber will consist of a small "place," with a notch in the centre, except the trees with the line cuts, each of which must have three notches, both upon the side which the line strikes, and flat upon which it leaves such trees. Miles posts must be set up every mile, and the distance marked thereon.
6. Stakes must be set at the crossing of fences and streams, and in intervals, and in meadows, and in groves, and in thickets, and in all places where the road may be liable to be obstructed.
7. These instructions in no way relieve you from each and every duty prescribed by the laws of Iowa Revision of 1860, pages 134 and 135.
8. All our assistants are required to be sworn by some person authorized to administer oaths.


