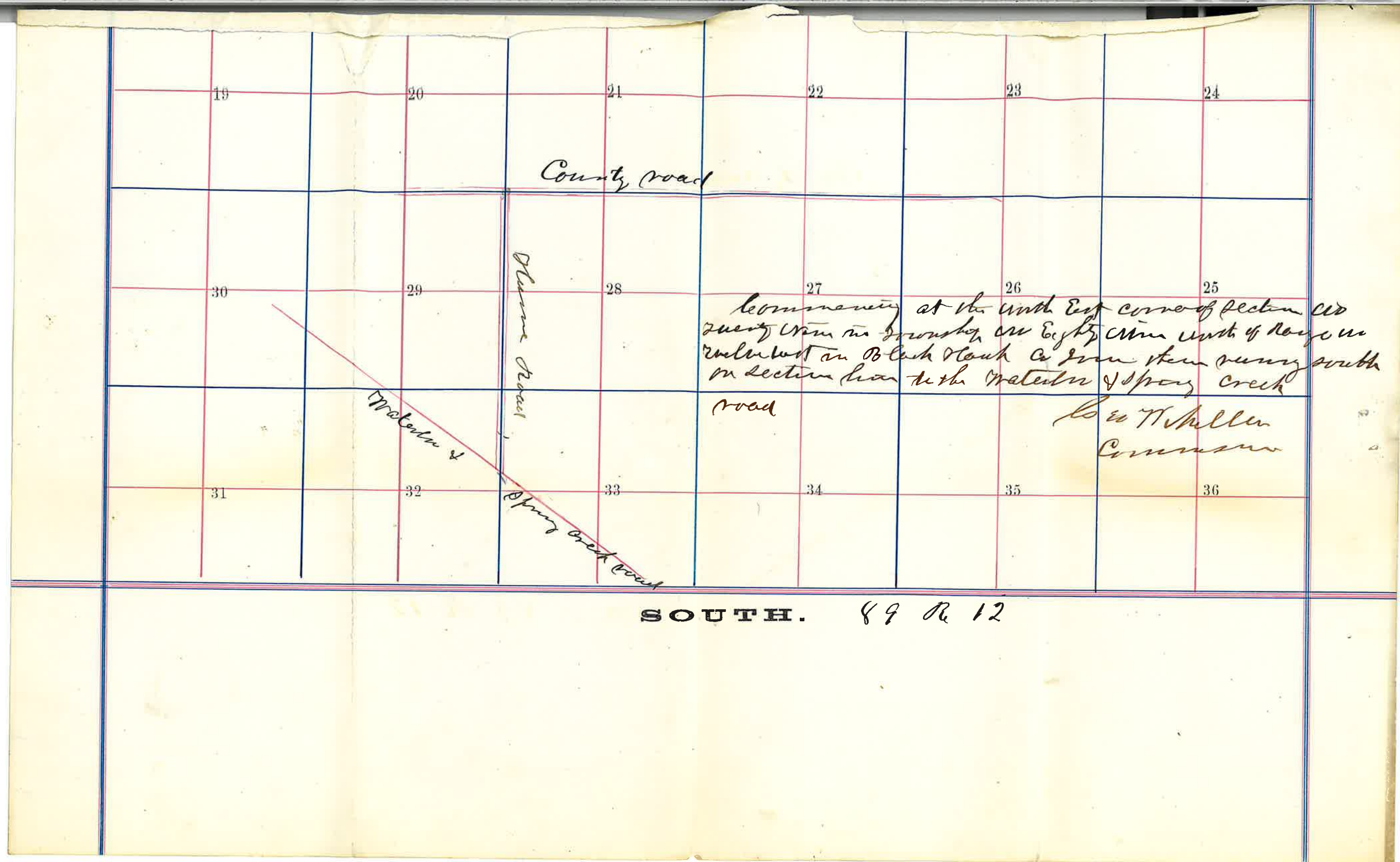

To *Samuel H. Muller*

You are hereby notified that you have been appointed a Commissioner to view, and if expedient, to locate a county road, petitioned for by *Samuel* _____ Road, and others, and to be called the _____ described as follows:

Commencing at the *farm where the Shablon & Spring*

Quarry Road crosses the section line between sections thirty two & thirty three Township 29 N. Range No. Twelve, that 50 p. and running north and south line to the North East corner of Section No. Twenty Nine (29) said Township and Range.

You will, therefore, appear at the office of some Justice of the Peace, Notary Public, or Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, and qualify according to law; and on the *7th* day of *June* 18*69*, you will proceed to commence the examination of the route above described, and if, in your judgment, the above road is needed, or one in the vicinity answering the same purpose, you will call to your assistance the necessary aid, and proceed to lay out and mark the same according to law and the following instructions, and report to the *Board* on or before the *15* day of *June* 18*69*.

1. In your survey of this road you will particularly describe the point of commencement, with reference to some monument record, which will be generally found to consist of corners in the public and private surveys; the exact course and distance from some one of which you must give in your field notes.
2. The point at which you terminate your survey must be ascertained and returned by reference to the same evidence as is herein required for the commencing point.
3. All letters and figures inscribed upon wood, or cast in a "wetting iron," similar to that used in the Government survey of lands.
4. Where bearing trees are taken, (and it is strongly enjoined that, if within ten chains of an angle, they should without fail be taken,) a smooth face fronting the angle of the road, should be made as near the elevated as practicable, and in this face should be cut the initial letters of the points of beginning and ending of the road. For example—a road from Point A to Point B, with bearing trees, can be marked by cutting the letters "A B" in the face of the tree, and the distance to a boundary, either, or corner of any "closed" tract, and in this is important, a large number of chains, and the point of each line cut, each of which must have three notches, both in the trunk and in the face of the tree, and that upon which it leaves such trees. All these must be set up at every mile, and the distance marked thereon. Stakes must be set at the crossing of fences and streams, and at intervals in the prairie not exceeding one-fourth of a mile each.
5. After completing your survey of this road, you must carefully protect the same upon paper, with a view to the detection of all errors, either in your chaining or course.
6. These instructions in no way relieve you from each and every duty prescribed by the laws of Iowa Revision of 1860, pages 124 and 125.
7. All your assistants are required to be sworn by some person authorized to administer oaths.
