road thirty three feet wide

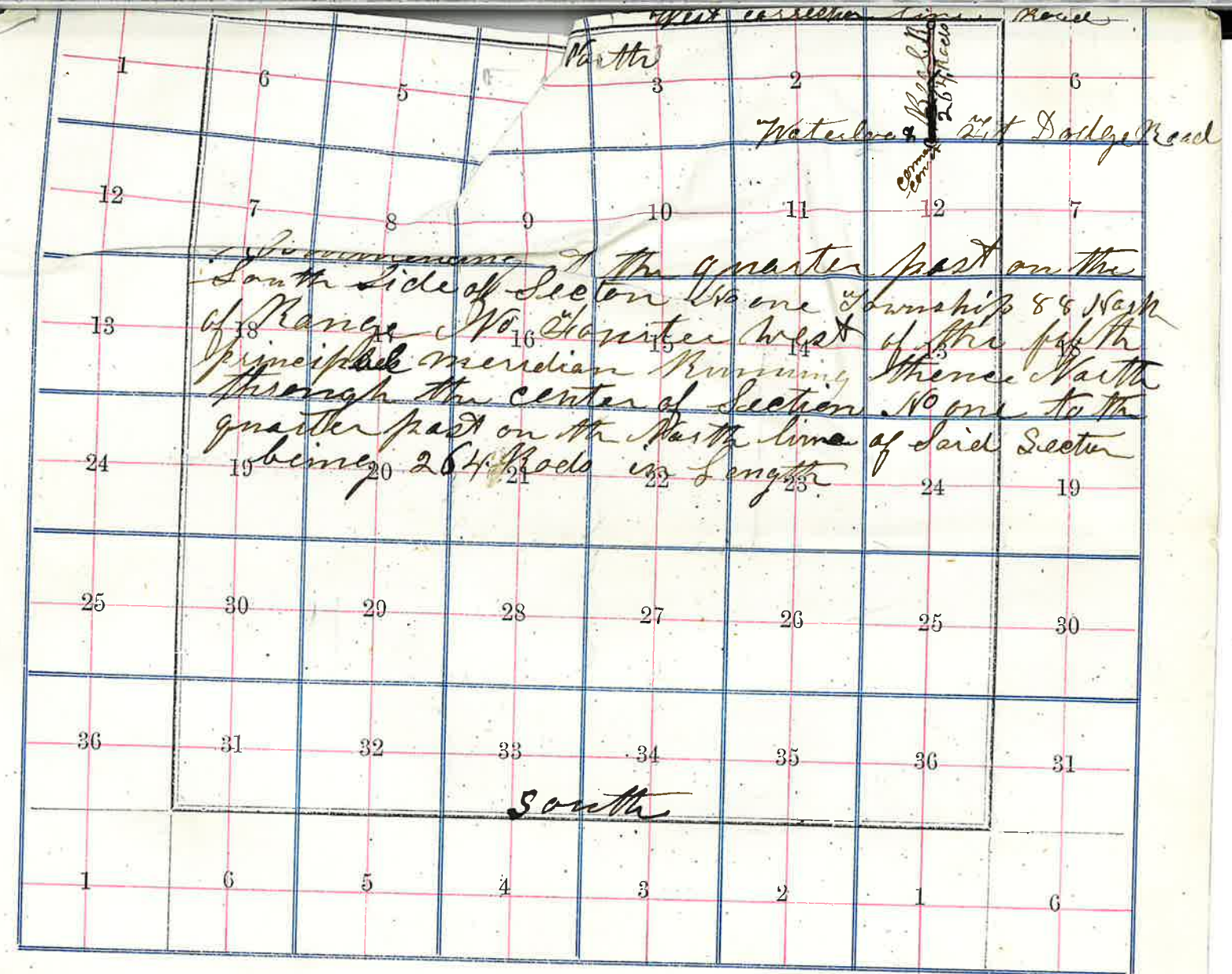

= siderable benefit to the public, and would hereby recommend its estab=
lishment.

You are hereby notified that you have been appointed a Commissioner to view, and if expedient, to locate a county road, petitioned for by *J. L. Beal* Road, and others, and to be called the *Beal* Road, described as follows:

Commencing at the *South quarter corner of Section 10*

One (1) in Township 10 S. Range 10 E. 1/4 (88) North of

Range 10 S. Township (14) West of the 3rd P. M.

thence South to the Corner of the same

thence to be thirty three (33) feet in width

You will, therefore, appear at the office of some Justice of the Peace, Notary Public, or Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, and qualify according to law; and on the *12* day of *July* 18 *69*, you will proceed to commence the examination of the route above described, and if, in your judgment, the above road is needed, or one in the vicinity answering the same purpose, you will call to your assistance the necessary aid, and proceed to lay out and mark the same according to law and the following instructions, and report to the Board on or before the *26th* day of *July* 18 *69*.

1. In your survey of this road you will particularly describe the point of commencement, with reference to some permanent record, which will be generally found to consist of corners in the public and private surveys; the exact course and distance from some one of which you must give in your field notes.
2. The point at which you terminate your survey must be ascertained and returned by reference to the same evidence as is herein required for the commencing point.
3. All letters and figures inscribed upon wood, or cut with a "marking iron," similar to that used in the Government survey of lands, and in the hearing of the road, should be made as in the enclosed certificate, and in this case should be cut the initial letters of the beginning and ending of the road. For example:—a road from D. C. to D. A. C. If a bearing of the road is taken, and where this is impracticable, a large mound of earth should be raised at the point of the angle, and a mark in timber will consist of a small "blaze" with a notch in the center, except the trees with the line cuts, each of which must have three notches, both upon the side which the line strikes, and that upon which it is such trees. All posts must be set up at every mile, and the distance marked thereon.
4. After completing your survey of this road, you must carefully protect the same upon paper, with a view to the detection of all errors, either in your chaining or course.
5. These instructions in no way relieve you from each and every duty prescribed by the laws of Iowa Revision of 1860, pages 134 and 135.
6. All your assistants are required to be sworn by some person authorized to administer oaths.
