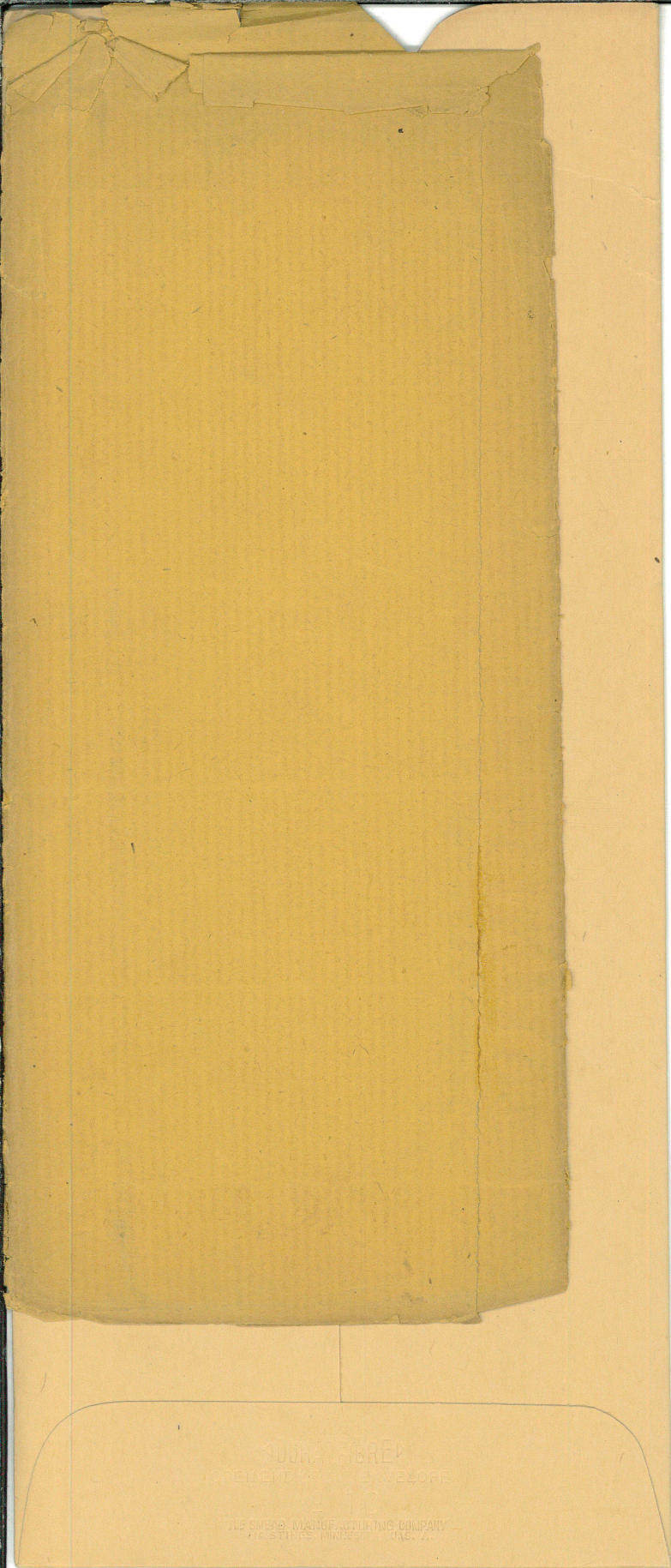

running North and South through the
centres of Section ~~20~~ 20 Township
87 & Range 11^W Thence due North
on the ^{as nearly} practicable section line until it
intersects the High way or Public
Road leading to Independence

South west corner of Section twenty nine
then due East eighty Rods thence North
across the Cedar River thence north so
near as practicable to Section twenty thence to
intersect with the Independence Road
