Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Amos of the County of Blackhawk and State of Iowa, are held and firmly bound unto the State for the use of Blackhawk County, in the sum of Twenty dollars, for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, and every one of them, firmly by these presents.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas Abner Leroy has this day made application by petition to the Board of Supervisors of said County, to appoint a Commissioner to view and change a road, to be called Weldon Reppert & Nelson Well Stake Road Now, if said Abner Leroy shall pay all costs that may be adjudged against him by the Board of Supervisors, in accordance with the statute in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.

The undersigned, having been appointed a Commissioner to view, and, if thought necessary, ^{change} ~~leave~~ a certain ^{State} Road in said County, petitioned for by More Sam and others, and known as Cedar Rapids & Marshall State Road, would report as follows :

That, having been duly sworn, ^{made meay ready} upon examination ~~that~~ it was inexpedient and ^{was} necessary, for the accommodation of the public, that the road should be ~~leave~~ ^{changed} as petitioned for.

Therefore, with the assistance of ^{as} ~~as~~ ^{surveyor,} ~~as~~ ^{chairmen,} ~~as~~ ^{men, who were all duly sworn, your} Commissioner proceeded on the day set ~~therefor,~~ ^{to-wit:} the ~~day~~ of ~~St. P. 18~~, to lay out and leave said ~~Road~~ and to distinguish the same by the proper marks, mounds, and stakes, in the manner prescribed by law, and in accordance with the ^{Field} ~~Field~~ Notes and ~~Plan~~ ^{Plan} of Survey of the Road, which are herewith annexed, and which are made part of this report.

Your Commissioner is of the opinion, that the road will be of great convenience and utility to the public, and would hereby recommend its establishment.
