You are hereby notified that you have been appointed a Commissioner to view, and if expedient, to locate a county road, petitioned for by C. H. Blanchard and others, and to be called the Blanchard Road,

described as follows:

Commencing at the "North" Road at the North East Cornerof Section 40 No. 17 in Township 40 N. RangeEast (88) North of Range No. 11 West of the 5th MeridianRunning North West to Section 36 East of the 5th Meridianto the North East Corner of Section 36North of Range No. 11 West of the 5th Meridian

You will, therefore, appear at the office of some Justice of the Peace, Notary Public, or Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, and qualify according to law; and on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of February 1871, you will proceed to commence the examination of the route above described, and if, in your judgment, the above road is needed, or one in the vicinity answering the same purpose, you will call to your assistance the necessary aid, and proceed to lay out and mark the same according to law and the following instructions, and report to the Board on or before the 10<sup>th</sup> day of March 1871.

1. In your survey of this road you will particularly describe the point of commencement, with reference to some monument record, which will be generally found to consist of corners in the public and private surveys; the exact course and distance from some one of which you must give in your field notes.
2. The point at which you terminate your survey must be ascertained and returned by reference to the same evidence as is herein required for the commencing point.
3. All letters and figures inscribed upon wood, must be cut with a "chinking iron," similar to that used in the Government survey of lands.
4. Where bearing trees are taken, (and it is strongly enjoined that, if within ten chains of an angle, they should without fail be taken,) a smooth face, fronting the angle of the road, should be made as near the ground as practicable, and in this face should be cut the initial letters of the points of beginning and ending of the road. For example:—a road from Death to Colony, D & C. R. When bearing trees cannot be had at angles, it is recommended the point of the angle, distance to a boulder, edifice, or corner of an enclosure, with a sketch in the center, and where this is impracticable, a large mound of earth should be raised at the point of the angle.
5. Marks in timber will consist of a smooth "chance" with a notch in the center, with a sketch in the center, and where this is impracticable, a large mound of earth should be raised at the point of the angle.
6. Stakes in timber will consist of a smooth "chance" with a notch in the center, with a sketch in the center, and where this is impracticable, a large mound of earth should be raised at the point of the angle.
7. After completing your survey of this road, you must carefully protect the same upon paper, with a view to the detection of all errors, either in your chaining or course.
8. These instructions in no way relieve you from each and every duty prescribed by the laws of Iowa Revision of 1860, pages 134 and 135.
