Yours Petitioner would respectfully ask that a Commission be appointed to examine into the expediency of changing, also vacating a part of the County Road running up Blackhawk Creek on the West side. The change part of said road as follows viz: Commencing at the South West corner of the South East quarter of the South West quarter of Section 28. in Township 39, N of Range 13 West of 5th P. Meridian, thence north about 30 rods, thence North Easterly until it intersects the half Section line running N. and South through the Centre of the 28. intersecting said line at few rods South of the Washington House, thence North and West to intersect the Centre line, thence running East and West, at the Centre of section 28, thence East around West to the quarter post between Sections 28 & 29, where it will intersect the present line of road. Road has the present line of road taken up and vacated between these two points.

Yours Petitioner would especially represent that the present line of road runs diagonally across the S. E. quarter of Section 28, 29, 13, and follows the boundary of the Blackhawk Creek which frequently crosses the bank and West, and also in the section line the road frequently filled with snow drifts which accumulate along the bank along the banks of said creek, so as to make it impossible for teams to either carry and haul or have to be hauled down, and as said line runs looks through fields of improved lands.

Now the proposed Road will now the whole distance over good ground
that never was frozen, and will be fenced with wire fences
so that the drifting Snow will have nothing to lodge against.
I have this proposed road shortens the length of Road to be
worked, as it will run on another Road 160 rods of the distance
between the Commencement and End of this proposed Road.
And the whole length of the proposed Road will exceed the
distance of the present travelled Road but a few Rods.

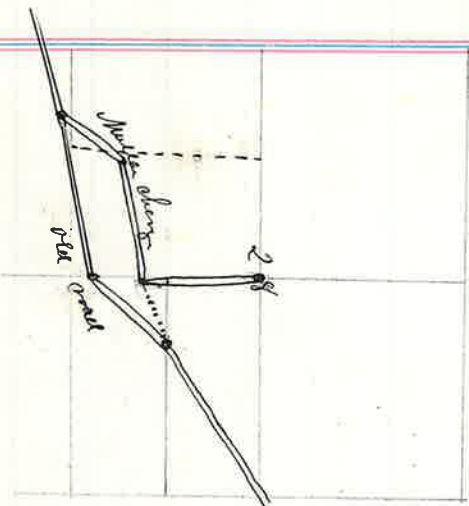

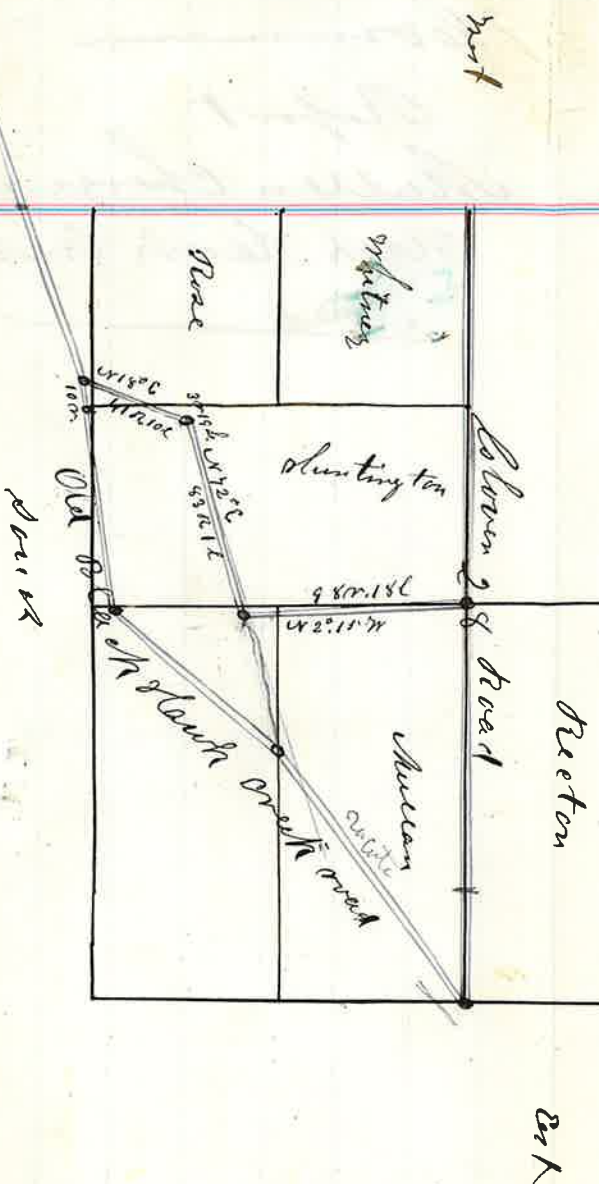

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, *Charles McClean*, of the County of Blackhawk and State of Iowa, are held and firmly bound unto the State for the use of Blackhawk County, in the sum of *Twenty* dollars, for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, and every one of them, firmly by these presents.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas *Charles McClean* has this day made application by petition to the Board of Supervisors of said County, to appoint a Commissioner to view and *locate* a road, to be called *the McClean Road*

Now, if said *Charles McClean* shall pay all costs that may be adjudged against him by the Board of Supervisors, in accordance with the statute in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.
