The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas *Sol Knapp* has this day made application by petition to the Board of Supervisors of said County, to appoint a Commissioner to view and *locate* a road, to be called *the Knapp*

Now, if said *Sol Knapp* shall pay all costs that may be adjudged against him by the Board of Supervisors, in accordance with the statute in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.
