locate a road, to be called Stus Thompson

Now, if said John D. Thompson shall pay all costs that may be adjudged against him by the Board of Supervisors, in accordance with the statute in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.

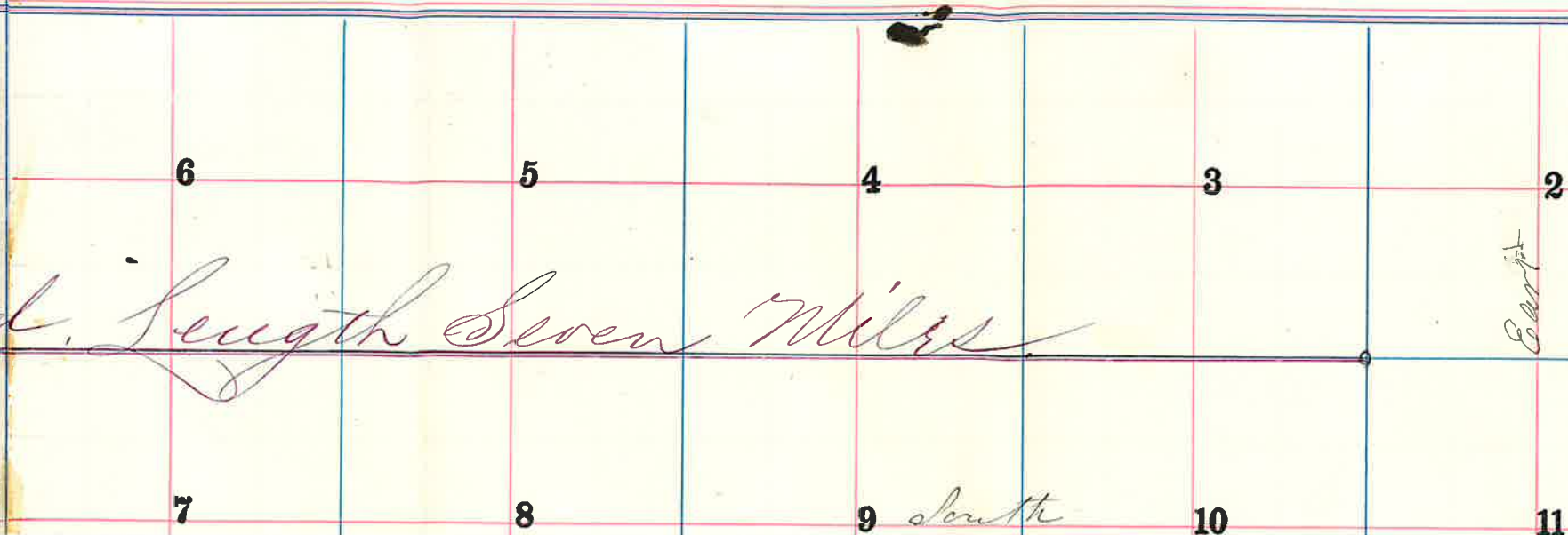

To the Honorable Board of Supervisors of said County :

The undersigned, having been appointed a Commissioner *de visu*, and, if thought necessary, locate a certain Road in said County, petitioned for by *Wm. J. Thompson* and others, and known as *the Thompson Road*, would report as follows :

That, having been duly sworn, he found, upon examination, that it was expedient and necessary, for the accommodation of the public, that the road should be located as petitioned for. *The road being on section lines no survey was necessary.*

~~as chairman,~~ ~~where, who were all duly sworn,~~ your Commissioner proceeded on the day set therefore, to-wit: the *21st* day of *June* A. D. 1871, to lay out and locate said Road, and to distinguish the same by the proper marks, monuments, and stakes, in the manner prescribed by law, and in accordance with the Field Notes and Plat of Survey of the Road, which are herewith annexed, and which are made part of this report.

Your Commissioner is of the opinion, that the road will be of great convenience and utility to the public, and would hereby recommend its establishment.

That on the 3rd day of July 1871 the Report
of the commissioners appointed to view said
Road was filed in the Office of the Clerk
of the Board of Supervisors, that said com-
missioners reported favorable to the location
of said Road, That the 4th day of
September 1871 is the day appointed for
