You are hereby notified that you have been appointed a Commissioner to view, and if expedient, to locate a county road, petitioned for by *Arthur Hamman* and others, and to be called the *Hamman* Road,

described as follows:

Commencing at the *State* West corner of Section 10 Township

North (24) in Twp. No. 6 N. R. 18 E. of Range No. 10

North (14) West of the 5th P.M. these boundaries

South on Section lines to the distant West corner of

Section 10 Township 6 N. R. 18 E. of Range No. 10 North of Range No. 10 Section (14) West of the 5th P.M.

You will, therefore, appear at the office of some Justice of the Peace, Notary Public, or Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, and qualify according to law; and on the *27th* day of *March* 18*77*, you will proceed to commence the examination of the route above described, and if, in your judgment, the above road is needed, or one in the vicinity answering the same purpose, you will call to your assistance the necessary aid, and proceed to lay out and mark the same according to law and the following instructions, and report to the Board on or before the *3rd* day of *July* 18*77*.

1. In your survey of this road you will particularly describe the point of commencement, with reference to some monument recent, which will be generally found to consist of corners in the public and private surveys; the exact course and distance from some one of which you must give in your field notes.
2. The point at which you terminate your survey must be ascertainable and returnable to the same evidence as is herein required for the commencing point.
3. All letters and figures inscribed upon wood, must be cut with a "marking pen," similar to that used in the Government survey of lands.
4. Where bearing trees are taken, (and it is strongly enjoined that, if within ten chains of an angle, they should without fail be taken,) a smooth face fronting the angle of the road, should be made as near the ground as practicable, and in this face should be cut the initial letters of the points of beginning and ending of the road. For example:—a road from Delhi to C. C. R. With bearing trees should be cut at angles, it is recommended that the bearing distance to a boundary, either, or corner of an enclosure be taken, and where this is impracticable, a large round or earth sign, if it is recommended that the angle be marked in timber with consist of a smooth "plate" with a notch in the center, except the trees with the notch in the center of which must have three notches, both upon the side which the line strikes, and that upon which it leaves such trees, and the points of the notch must be marked with a view to the detection of all errors, either in your strikes must be set at the crossing of fences and streams, and at intervals in the private not exceeding one-fourth of a mile each.
6. After completing your survey of this road, you must carefully protect the same upon paper, with a view to the detection of all errors, either in your chaining or course.
7. These instructions in no way relieve you from each and every duty prescribed by the laws of Iowa Revision of 1860, pages 134 and 135.
8. All your assistants are required to be sworn by some person authorized to administer oaths.
