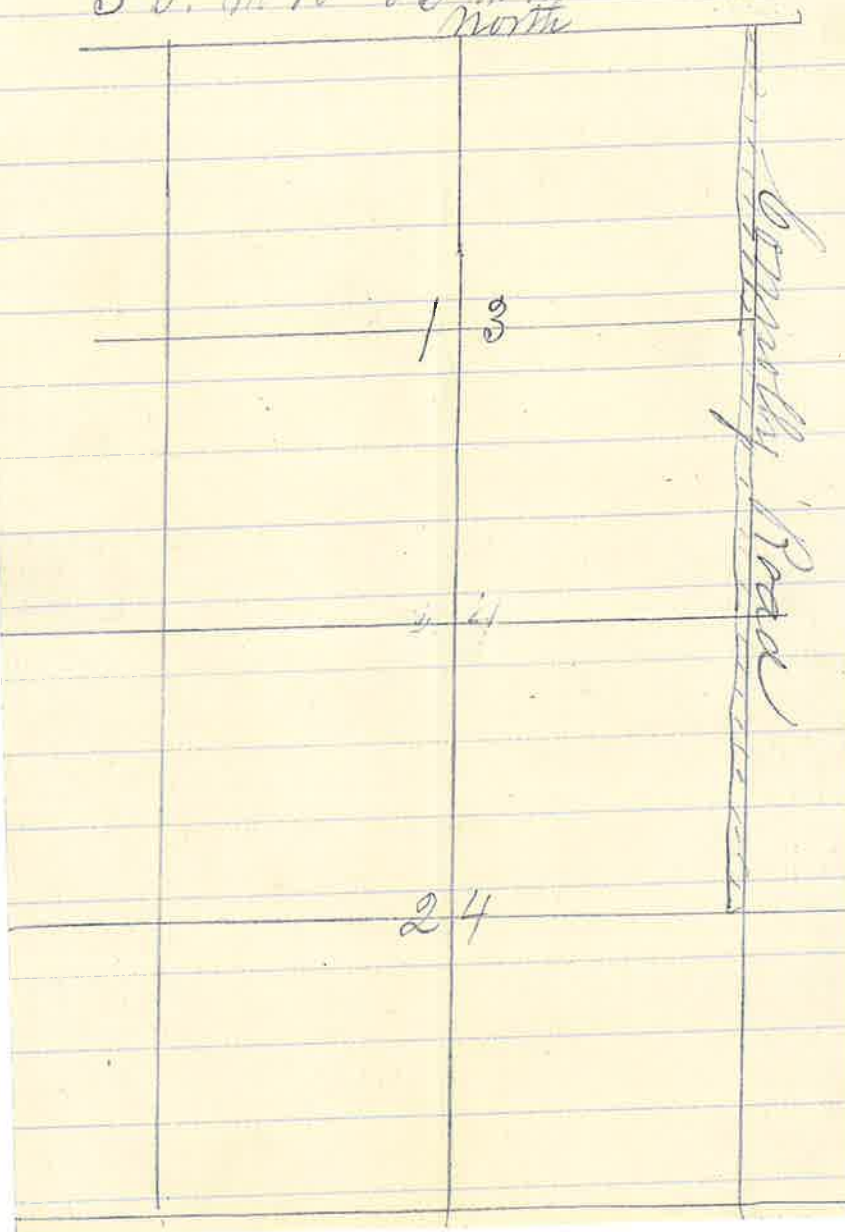

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, *Martin V. Wolgamut, Fred K. Kraft and George Wetherington*, of the County of Blackhawk and State of Iowa, are held and firmly bound unto the State for the use of Blackhawk County, in the sum of *Twenty* dollars, for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, and every one of them, firmly by these presents.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas *Patrick Connolly* has this day made application by petition to the Board of Supervisors of said County, to appoint a Commissioner to view and *locate* a road, to be called *the Connolly Road*

Now, if said *Patrick Connolly* shall pay all costs that may be adjudged against him by the Board of Supervisors, in accordance with the statute in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.

With regard to Co. line road, we appoint Commissioners from each county to meet on the same day, view and report jointly to both offices. In the case to which you refer (west line of Sec. 18-90-10) I will appoint a Commissioner to view on the 18th of August and report on the 21st, the Com^{rs} to meet at the house of Patrick Connally, near SW cor. section 18 at 10 o'clock A.M., of said 18th of Aug if such action be agreeable to you. Subsequent action will be the same as in other cases, except that the road cannot be established until both counties have acted favorably upon it, each Auditor reporting such action officially to the other.
