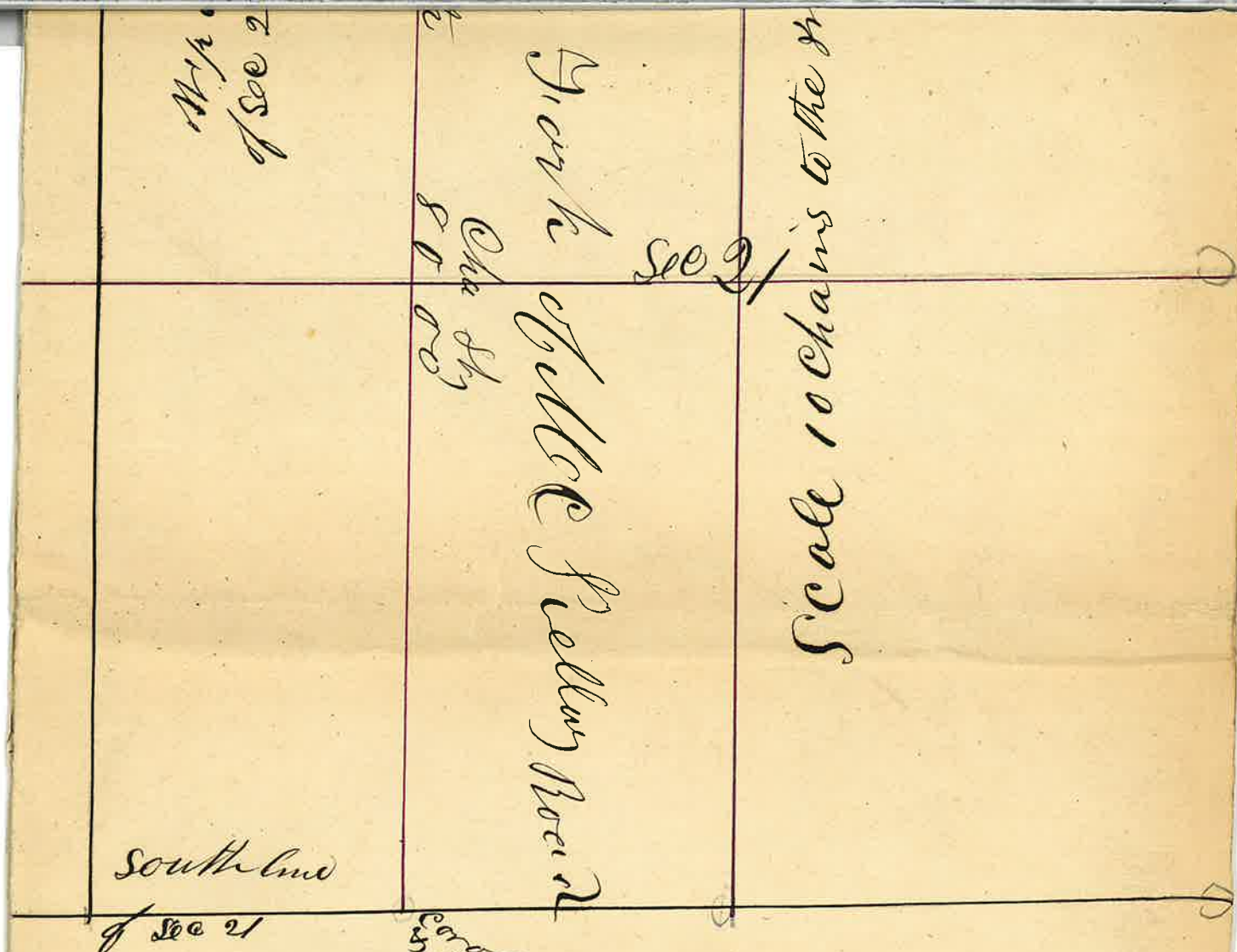

**To the Honorable Board of Supervisors of said County:**

The undersigned, having been appointed a Commissioner to view, and, if thought necessary, to locate a certain Road in said County petitioned for by Nelson McFeller and others, and known as the McFeller Road, would report as follows:

That, having been duly sworn, he found, upon examination, that it was a Rectilinear  
Route and very much checked  
for the accommodation of the public, that the road should be located  
as petitioned for.

Therefore with the assistance of *Michael* as surveyor  
*John McCallan &* as chairmen,  
*Joseph Solina*  
*Abelton & McCallan* axmen, who were all duly sworn, your Com-  
missioner proceeded on the day set therefor, to-wit: the *17<sup>th</sup>* day of *June 1872* to  
*claim & on the 18<sup>th</sup> of June*  
A. D. 1872, to lay out and locate said Road, and to distinguish the same by the proper  
marks, mounds and stakes, in the manner prescribed by law, and in accordance  
with the Field Notes and Plat of Survey of the Road, which are hereunto annexed, and  
which are made part of this report.

Your Commissioner is of the opinion, that the road will be of great use & benefit to the Public & Petitioners in Particular & to the public, and would hereby earnestly recommend its location ~~to the~~
