to be expended as follows, to wit:
Two hundred fifty dollars to buy the
right of water land the right of way

in the Road known as the North
Richard Road: beginning at the N. E.
corner of the Schoolhouse site, in East-
brook Mo, and thence south along
the line of said site to the S. E. corner
of the same, thence west to the west
line of said Co. B. Blackhawk's farm.

Twenty dollars to buy the right
of way from the existing point
above described, diagonally across
the corner of H. F. McLeod's farm to
intersect the above named Road
at the east end of the bridge near the
residence of said H. F. McLeod.

Said Road to be sixty six feet
wide.

Forty dollars or so much stamp
as may be needed to pay for measuring
the bridge to conform to said change.

We would respectfully represent, that, by making the change as contemplated in the foregoing, the County will save the building and repairing of one bridge that would cost about two hundred dollars, besides avoiding thirty or forty rods of the road. Road to build and keep in repair in the County.

At the time of high water, the creek runs for several rods up in the middle of the road and will eventually make the main channel there subsiding the road entirely.
