You are hereby notified that you have been appointed a Commissioner to elect, and is expedient to locate county road all petitioned by August

Jeffy

and others, and to be called the

Road, described as follows:

Commencing at the South East corner of the North East Quarter of Section 1st Twenty four (24) in Township 1st N. County (90) North of Range 1st E. Eleven (11) West of the 5th P.M. thence running bearing on half section line three fourths (3/4) of a mile to intersect the Road running North and South.

I therefore, appear before some officer authorized to administer oaths in and for said county, and qualify according to law; and on the South day of February 1874, you will proceed to commence the examination of the route above described, and if, in your judgment, the above road is needed, or one in the vicinity answering the same purpose, you will call to your assistance the necessary aid, and proceed to lay out and mark the same according to law and the following instructions, and report to the Board on or before the first day of February 1874.

1. In your survey of this road you will particularly describe the point of commencement, with reference to some monument, record, which will be generally found to consist of corners in the public and private surveys; the exact course and distance from some one of which you must give in your field notes.
2. The point at which you terminate your survey must be ascertained and returned by reference to the same evidence as is herein required for the commencing point.
3. All letters and figures inscribed upon wood, must be cut with a "marking iron," similar to that used in the Government survey of lands.
4. Where bearing trees are taken, (and it is strongly enjoined that if within ten chains of an angle they should without fail be taken,) a smooth tree fronting the angle of the road, should be marked in the ground by a "V" and in this tree should be cut the initial letters of the points of beginning and ending of the road, and the word "Road" in the ground by a "V" and in this tree should be cut the initial letters of the points of beginning and ending of the road.
5. Marks in timber will consist of a notch, "blaze," with a notch in the centre, and where this is inscribed trees cannot be cut at angles, and the distance to a boundary, either corner of an enclosure be taken, and where this is inscribed trees cannot be cut at angles, and the distance to a boundary, either corner of an enclosure be taken.
6. After completing your survey of this road, you must carefully protect the same upon paper, with a view to the detection of all errors, either in your staking or course.
7. These instructions in no way relieve you from each and every duty prescribed by the laws of Iowa Revision of 1860, pages 134 and 135.
