W. corner of said Denim & Lee's Addition* thence *N. 57° 10' W. 34 50 chains to 1/4 Sec. line* thence *North* with *1/4 Sec. line* 10.46 chains to *1/4 cor. between* *Secs 14 & 15 Township 89 N Range 13 W* thence *North* 20 chs to the *cedar* *Orlando Road*

You will, therefore, appear before some officer authorized to administer oaths in and for said county, and qualify according to law; and on the *10th* day of *Oct* 1874 you will proceed to commence the examination of the route above described, and if, in your judgment, the above road is needed, or one in the vicinity answering the same purpose, you will call to your assistance the necessary aid, and proceed to lay out and mark the same according to law and the following instructions, and report to the Board on or before the *25th* day of *Nov* 1874.

1. In your survey of this road you will particularly describe the point of commencement, with reference to some monument record, which will be generally found to consist of corners in the public and private surveys; the exact course and distance from some one of which you must give in your field notes.
2. The point at which you terminate your survey must be ascertained and returned by reference to the same evidence as is herein required for the commencing point.
3. All letters and figures inscribed upon wood, must be cut with a "marking iron," similar to that used in the Government survey of lands.
4. Where bearing trees are taken, (and it is strongly enjoined that it within ten chains of an angle, they should without fail be taken,) a smooth face fronting the angle of the road, should be made as near the ground as practicable, and in this face should be cut the initial letters of the points of beginning and ending of the road. For example:—a road from Delhi to Colony—D & C R. When bearing trees cannot be had at angles, it is recommended the bearing and distance to a boundary, either, or corner of an enclosure be taken, and where this is impracticable, a large mound of earth should be raised at the point of the angle.
5. Marks in timber will consist of a smith "blaze," with a notch in the centre, except the trees with the fine cuts, each of which must have three notches, both upon the side which the line strikes, and that upon which it leaves such trees. All posts must be set up at every mile, and the distance marked thereon.—Such marks must be set at the crossing of fences and streams, and at intervals in the public not exceeding one-fourth of a mile each.
6. These instructions in no way relieve you from each and every duty prescribed by the laws of Iowa Revision of 1880, pages 124 and 135.
7. All your assistants are required to be sworn by some person authorized to administer oaths.

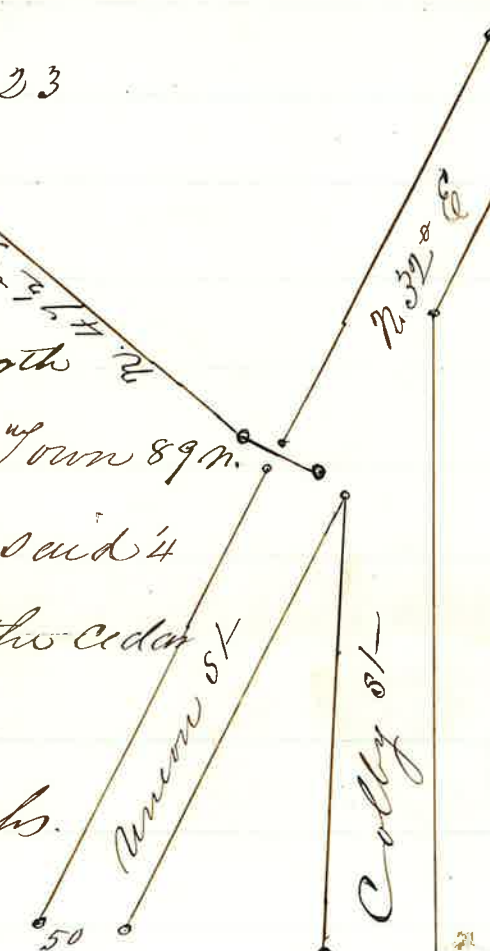

To the Honorable Board of Supervisors of said County:

The undersigned, having been appointed a Commissioner to view, and, if thought necessary, locate a certain Road in said County petitioned for by *E. J. Arnold* and others, and known as the *Hamlet* Road, would report as follows:

That, having been duly sworn, he found, upon examination, that it was a Road much needed for the accommodation of the public, that the road should be located as petitioned for.

Therefore with the assistance of *Stanley Proctor* as surveyor *E. J. Arnold* as chainmen, and *J. W. Allen* as chain and axmen, who were all duly sworn, your Commissioner proceeded on the day set therefor, to-wit: the 10th day of October A. D. 1874, to lay out and locate said Road, and to distinguish the same by the proper marks, mounds and stakes, in the manner prescribed by law, and in accordance with the Field Notes and Plat of Survey of the Road, which are herunto annexed, and which are made part of this report.
